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TOTAL VISITOR SPENDING FOR THE FIRST SEVEN MONTHS OF 2011 INCREASED 16.1 PERCENT

July 2011 Total Visitors Spending Grew 5.2 Percent, Despite a 1.9 Percent Decline in Visitor Arrivals

HONOLULU – Total expenditures by visitors who came to Hawai'i in the first seven months of 2011 increased 16.1 percent, compared to the same period last year, to \$7.2 billion. Total visitor days for all visitors rose 5.3 percent, and total arrivals maintained a 3.6 percent lead over last year at 4,234,156 visitors, according to preliminary statistics released today by the Hawai'i Tourism Authority.

For the month of July 2011, total visitor expenditures rose 5.2 percent (\$55.8 million) from July 2010 to \$1.1 billion. Contributing to the increase was higher daily spending by all visitors (\$177 per person, up from \$164 per person in July 2010), despite a decline in total arrivals (-1.9%) to 668,193 visitors.

Arrivals by air only in July 2011 fell 1.9 percent from last July to 667,707 visitors. Arrivals from Canada jumped 28.6 percent compared to July 2010, the thirteenth consecutive month of double-digit growth. U.S. East arrivals decreased 6 percent from July 2010. Japanese arrivals dropped 9.2 percent compared to July 2010 after four consecutive months of double-digit losses. Arrivals from U.S. West (-1%) declined for a second month.

A total of 486 visitors arrived by cruise ship in July 2011, an off-season month for Hawai'i's international cruise industry. No visitors came by cruise ship last July.

There continued to be double-digit growth in total spending by U.S. West (+10.2%), U.S. East (+11.9%) and Canadian (+31.7%) visitors in the first seven months of 2011, boosted by higher average daily spending and increased arrivals. Total Japanese visitor spending also rose (+5.3%), even though Japanese arrivals declined 9.2 percent compared to year-to-date 2010.

Additional Total Air Visitor Highlights:

- The decline in U.S. West and U.S. East visitors in July 2011 was expected due to three events held in July 2010 that did not take place in July 2011. Two large conventions and the biennial Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) multi-nation military exercise brought a considerable number of visitors to the islands last July (see U.S. West, U.S. East and Meetings, Conventions, Incentive Visitor Highlights).

- For the fourth consecutive month, there was a double-digit decline in the total number of visitors who went on group tours. The drop in total group tour activities (-13.5%) in July 2011 was due to decreases from Japan (-22.6%), U.S. East (-14.9%) and U.S. West (-7%).

- Fewer total visitors stayed in hotels (-2.6%) compared to July 2010, the second month of decline. In contrast, more total visitors stayed in condominium properties (+1.2%) compared to last July. There has been positive growth in total visitors who stay in condominium properties every month since January 2009.
- Among the larger Hawaiian Islands, Kaua'i (+2.4%) showed growth in total visitor arrivals in July 2011, supported by recently added direct air service from Oakland and San Jose and increased service from San Francisco. Total visitor arrivals to O'ahu (-3.7%) and Hawai'i Island (-2.1%) declined, while total visitor arrivals to Maui (-0.2%) were about the same as last July.

Major Market Areas:

U.S. West:

- Despite lower arrivals, higher daily spending by U.S. West visitors (\$146 per person, compared to \$138 per person in July 2010) contributed to a 2.9 percent increase in total spending to \$406.4 million for July 2011.
- The decline in U.S. West visitors (-1%) in July 2011 was mainly due to lower arrivals from international flights. U.S. West arrivals on domestic flights were unchanged from last July.
- There was an expected drop in the number of U.S. West (-17.3%) visitors who came for government/military purposes compared to July 2010, due to the absence of RIMPAC which is held every two years in Hawai'i.
- Arrivals from the Pacific Region dropped slightly (-0.9%) compared to July 2010 due to a 2 percent decline from California that offset increases from Alaska (+35.1%), Washington (+2.1%) and Oregon (+1.1%). Arrivals from the Mountain Region increased 4.3 percent from July 2010 (Table 2).
- More U.S. West visitors came to the islands to honeymoon (+2.5%) compared to July 2010.
- For the first seven months of 2011, total expenditures by U.S. West visitors increased 10.2 percent to \$2.4 billion. Total visitors days (+3.5%) and visitor arrivals (+3.8%) were also higher compared to the same period last year.

U.S. East:

- Spending by U.S. East visitors in July 2011 decreased 6 percent to \$309.1 million as a result of lower visitor arrivals. The average daily spending by these visitors was \$178 per person, up from \$176 per person in July 2010.
- Arrivals from the West North Central (+3.5%) region increased but arrivals from all other U.S. East regions were lower compared to July 2010: East South Central (-14.1%); Middle Atlantic (-13.1%); New England (-8.6%); South Atlantic (-6.7%); West South Central (-3.5%) and East North Central (-3%) (Table 2).

- There was a higher proportion of U.S. East repeat visitors in July 2011 (57.9%) compared to July 2010 (55.2%). Since April 2011, there has been a greater proportion of U.S. East repeat visitors compared to the same months in 2010.
- The number of U.S. East visitors who came for government/military purposes declined 27.7 percent compared to last July.
- For the first seven months of 2011, total spending by U.S. East visitors grew 11.9 percent to \$2 billion. Visitor days increased 2.5 percent and visitor arrivals were up 1.5 percent compared to the first seven months of 2010.

Japan:

- Despite a 9.2 percent drop in Japanese arrivals in July 2011, higher average daily spending (\$267 per person, up from \$242 per person in July 2010) contributed to a 3.9 percent growth in total visitor spending to \$172.3 million. Higher lodging costs, and increased spending on shopping and food and beverage, contributed to the growth in daily spending.
- The average length of stay by total Japanese visitors increased to 6.33 days compared to 6.09 days in July 2010.
- Japanese arrivals to Hawai'i Island (-19.9% to 13,684 visitors), Maui (-18.9% to 4,466 visitors) and O'ahu (-8.9% to 97,588 visitors) declined. Only arrivals to Kaua'i (+19% to 2,041 visitors) increased compared to July 2010.
- The number of Japanese visitors who purchased group tours fell 22.6 percent from July 2010 to 24,760 visitors, the fifth consecutive month of double-digit decreases. In contrast, more Japanese visitors in July 2011 made their own travel arrangements (FIT), which rose 2 percent compared to last July.
- More total Japanese visitors stayed exclusively in condominium (+4.2%) or time-share properties (+4.8%) compared to last July, the third consecutive month of increases.
- While total Japanese arrivals for the first seven months of 2011 also dropped by 9.2 percent, average daily spending was higher at \$282 per person, compared to \$253 per person, in the first seven months of 2010. Total spending by Japanese visitors for the first seven months of 2011 was \$1.1 billion, an increase of 5.3 percent compared to year-to-date 2010.

Canada:

- Total spending by Canadian visitors in July 2011 jumped 37.9 percent to \$46.4 million, supported by a 28.6 percent growth in arrivals and higher average daily spending by these visitors (\$150 per person, up from \$134 per person in July 2010).
- Canadian visitors who came on international flights climbed 49.2 percent compared to July 2010 (Table 7).
- Significantly more Canadian visitors in July 2011 traveled FIT (+31.5%) compared to last July.

- For the first seven months of 2011, total expenditures by Canadian visitors grew 31.7 percent to \$576.8 million. Total visitors days increased 19.8 percent, while visitor arrivals rose 21.5 percent from the same period last year.

Island Highlights:

- For the month of July 2011, total visitor spending on O'ahu (+8.8% to \$583.4 million), Maui (+3.4% to \$286.1 million) and Kaua'i (+16.3% to \$133.5 million) increased. Total visitor spending on Hawai'i Island (-14.3% to \$117.1 million) declined due to lower average daily spending, largely caused by decreased arrivals from Japan.
- For the first seven months of 2011, total visitor spending and arrivals increased on all islands compared to the same period last year. Year to date, visitor spending on O'ahu, Maui, Kaua'i and Lāna'i has shown increases in every month of 2011.

Island Highlights for Selected MMAs:

- **Kaua'i:** The growth in total arrivals to Kaua'i (+2.4%) in July 2011 was boosted by increases from U.S. West (+6.2%), Japan (+19%) and Canada (+21.9%). U.S. East (-3.8%) arrivals to this island were lower compared to July 2010. For the first seven months of 2011, arrivals to Kaua'i by Canadian visitors (+23.9%) were significantly higher compared to the same period last year. Visitors to Kaua'i from U.S. West (+4.9%), U.S. East (+1.5%) and Japan (+5%) also increased.
- **O'ahu:** Total arrivals to O'ahu in July 2011 fell 3.7 percent compared to July 2010, due to lower arrivals from U.S. East (-10.3%), U.S. West (-4.4%) and Japan (-8.9%), which offset a 31.5 percent growth in arrivals from Canada. For the first seven months of 2011, arrivals to O'ahu from Canada (+23.7%) and U.S. West (+1.2%) were higher compared to year-to-date 2010. Japanese arrivals fell 8.8 percent, while U.S. East arrivals (+0.3%) to O'ahu were similar to the same period last year.
- **Hawai'i Island:** Total arrivals to Hawai'i Island in July 2011 dropped 2.1 percent compared to 2011. Lower arrivals from Japan (-19.9%), U.S. East (-2.7%) and U.S. West (-1.2%) negated a 24.7 percent growth in arrivals from Canada. For the first seven months of 2011, arrivals to Hawai'i Island from Canada (+25.9%), U.S. West (+6%) and U.S. East (+2.8%) increased, though Japanese arrivals declined 20.8 percent from year-to-date 2010.
- **Maui:** Total arrivals to Maui in July (-0.2%) were similar to July 2010. Decreases in arrivals from U.S. West (-1.5%), U.S. East (-4.4%) and Japan (-18.9%) were offset by a 15.7 percent growth in arrivals from Canada. For the first seven months of 2011, arrivals to Maui by Canadian visitors (+17.8%) were much higher compared to the same period last year. Visitors to Maui from U.S. West (+3.9%) and U.S. East (+2.7%) also increased, but Japanese arrivals declined 7.1 percent compared to the same period last year.

Meetings, Conventions, Incentive Visitor Highlights:

- Meeting Convention and Incentive (MCI) visitors fell 24.4 percent compared to July 2010.

- As expected, the total number of visitors who came for conventions in July 2011 declined sharply (-36.9%) compared to last July as a result of decreases from U.S. East (-48.1%), Japan (-32.7%) and U.S. West (-8.2%). While there were moderate convention activities in July 2011, the International Conference on Alzheimer's Disease and the Baptist World Congress brought a total of 11,000 delegates to the islands in July 2010.
- Total visitors who came for corporate meetings increased 12 percent compared to July 2010.
- The total number of visitors who came on incentives rose 18.3 percent from July 2010, boosted by growth from U.S. East (+50% to 2,228 visitors) and U.S. West (+63.3% to 1,430 visitors).
- For the first seven months of 2011, the total number of MCI visitors grew 31.2 percent from year-to-date 2010 with increases from all segments: conventions (+33.6%), corporate meetings (+28.7%) and incentives (+27.1%).

Total Scheduled Air Seats to Hawai'i (Table 9, page 25):

- Total air seats for July 2011 fell 1.8 percent from the same month last year due to fewer seats from U.S. East (-35.2%) and Japan (-4.7%). Air seats from other markets increased compared to last July.
- The decline in seats from U.S. East resulted from the suspension of flights from Charlotte, Detroit and Minneapolis. In addition, there were reductions in service from Chicago to Honolulu and Kahului, and from Houston to Honolulu.
- Air seat capacity from the U.S. West market (+0.4%) rose slightly from July 2010. Seat capacity from Denver (+46.8%), Las Vegas (+9.6%), Salt Lake (+21.3%) and San Jose (+38.4%) continued to climb while there was a doubling of seats from Anchorage. These increases were offset by fewer seats from Los Angeles, San Francisco, Seattle, Portland and San Diego compared to July 2010.
- International air seats increased 7.2 percent overall, though there were fewer seats from Japan for all airports except Tokyo's Haneda International Airport.
- An increase in flight activity from Vancouver to Honolulu and Kahului by WestJet increased seats from Canada by 51.5 percent.
- The availability of air seats from South Korea rose 71.8 percent in July 2011 compared to the same month last year.
- Total seat capacity from Oceania jumped 43.8 percent compared to July 2010. A doubling of Hawaiian Airlines' flights from Sydney, and smaller increases by Qantas and Jetstar, contributed to a 51.1 percent growth in seats from Australia. In addition, air seats from New Zealand rose 17.1 percent from July 2010.

Cruise Ship Visitors (Table 8, page 24):

- There was a total of 11,796 cruise visitors in July 2011, a decline of 5.3 percent from last July. Total cruise visitor days fell 4.3 percent and total days spent in Hawai'i was 10.8, compared to 10.68 days in July 2010.
- One cruise ship came in July 2011, with 486 visitors on board, compared to zero ships last year.
- For the first seven months of 2011, a total of 134,110 visitors came by cruise ship or by air to board cruise ships, 6.7 percent higher compared to year-to-date 2010. Visitor days for all cruise ship visitors rose 4.9 percent from the same period last year.
