

- > 4 WILDFIRES AT THE SAME TIME: OLINDA, KULA, KIHEI AND LAHAINA
- > 2,170 ACRES BURNED.
- > 2,000+ Homes Burned.
- > 800+ BUSINESSES BURNED.
- ➤ OLINDA FIRES 95% CONTAINED. LAHAINA FIRE CONTAINED ON 9/3/23.
- LOSS FROM BUSINESSES AND TOURISM DROP AT \$11 MILLION A DAY.


## **LODGING/TRANSPORTATION**

- 500 UNITS DESTROYED IN LAHAINA
- 5,500 SURVIVORS ARE BEING HOUSED IN HOTELS ACROSS MAUI.
- OF MAUI'S RENTAL FLEET OF ABOUT 22,000 CARS, ABOUT A QUARTER ARE BEING UTILIZED IT'S USUALLY 80-90%.



#### Domestic Daily Passenger Count, by County




#### Flight Capacity, Kahului Airport



#### Domestic Daily Passenger Count, Maui County




#### Air Seats Capacity, Kahului Airport
