The Airline Industry Remains In a Unique Position



Labor shortages including pilots, mechanics and ground staff have limited the ability to grow and have constrained day-to-day operations – not to mention the increased cost to airline P&L



Fuel cost increases, for some carriers > 100% higher versus pre-pandemic, are largely offsetting revenue performance




Record revenues driven by the recovery of leisure traffic and ongoing restoration of business travel demand; Yields (higher fares) are performing well; Transatlantic recovery is doing far better than Transpacific



New labor rates will add \$billions in new expense to airline balance sheets and put pressure on earnings

New pilot contracts to drive up costs at U.S. airlines



"Margins are set to take a hit in 2023 as airlines ratify new contracts with labor groups," Cowen analyst Helane Becker said last month.

"We expect pilot pay, which represents approximately 40% of labor expense, will increase by 20% to 30% under the new agreements."


Jet Fuel prices have almost come down to where they were pre-COVID, but remain volatile...outlook is negative due to Saudi & Russian cuts


Airlines (Southwest) are revising RASM (Revenue Per Available Seat Mile) guidance to down -5% to -7% for Q3, others expected to follow

Change (%) in TSA Checkpoint Volume: Jan-Aug 2023 vs. Jan-Aug 2019




Day of Week and Rank (by Volume)

Domestic Air Travel to Hawaiian Islands is Stabilizing, Maui again exceeds Island of Hawai'i in Daily Passenger Arrivals







Non-Stop Transpac Air Seat Reductions into OGG compared to 2022








Non-Stop International Markets into Hawai'i (all airports)





Canada Seats 2018-2023P








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Japan Seats 2018-2023P



South Korea Seats 2018-2023P




China Seats 2018-2020
