Hawai'i Convention Center's September Highlights for the October 2023

HTA Board of Director's Meeting

October 25, 2023

- September 2023 HCC hosted 20 licensed events during the month
- A few Local Events: Okinawan Festival, PBX Hawaii, PLC Institute
- A large city-wide Conference "Best Western Hotels Annual Conference (corporate event with 1M in F&B spend)
- We continued to house the Department of Business and Economic Development and Federal Emergency Management Association in support of the Maui wildfires

<u>Financials:</u>

- Gross revenues for the month exceeded \$2.6 million
- Posted facility <u>net income of +\$504,000</u> for September
- This is our 3rd consecutive month of posting a positive bottom line primarily due to Citywide/Corporate business
- The economic and financial impacts of citywide business, like Best Western in September and the five other city-wide events during July and August highlight the importance to improved results for both HCC financials and State economic impact.
- Our FY24 reforecast for both revenue (\$21M) and bottom line net loss (\$2.5M) is significantly favorable to budget by 2M

***We also want to highlight that in September we moved our R&M and advance deposit funds from a savings account into a government treasury obligation that will yield significantly higher returns on interest.

Included in the FY24 reforecast is interest income just shy of \$900k (originally budgeted at \$60k)

***We will be removing the \$900k interest income from the reforecast moving forward per Isaac

Our facility net loss would be \$3.4 million which would still be a significant favorable variance against the \$5.3 million net loss budgeted, \$2 million positive variance without the interest added

HCC Revenue + State Revenue + Tax Revenue

=\$135.6 M

HCC Expense + HVCB MCI Expense = \$7.3 M



 - 2023 Made in Hawaii Festival (12 trees)
 - 2023 Okinawan Festival (11 trees)

Repair, Maintenance and Replacement Update

- 1. 16 projects being executed; value \$11.6M
 - a. Chiller Replacement, \$6.9M
 - i. Currently on schedule for completion in June 2024, within budget
- 2. 8 projects being procured; value \$29.4M
 - a. Exterior Building Painting, \$6M
 - b. Exterior Planter Repair \$11M
- 3. 16 projects being planned for procurement; value \$39.5M
