Hawai'i Passenger Arrivals By Air

HONOLULU – Today marks one week since the state's 14-day mandatory self-quarantine started for all passengers arriving in Hawai'i from out of state. The order was expanded yesterday to include interisland travelers as well. This table shows the number of people who arrived by air from out of state yesterday and does not include interisland travel.

Yesterday, 664 people arrived in Hawai'i, and of that number, 120 people were visitors. Most of the passengers were returning residents. In comparison, during this same time last year, more than 30,000 passengers arrived in Hawai'i daily, including residents and visitors.
