## Hawai'i Passenger Arrivals By Air

**HONOLULU** – Yesterday, 628 people arrived in Hawai'i including 94 visitors and 239 residents. In comparison, during this same time last year, nearly 30,000 passengers arrived in Hawai'i daily, including residents and visitors. The state's 14-day mandatory self-quarantine started last week Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup>, for all passengers arriving in Hawai'i from out of state. The order was expanded on April 1<sup>st</sup> to include interisland travelers. This table shows the number of people who arrived by air from out of state yesterday and does not include interisland travel.
