### Hawaii Passenger Arrivals By Air

**HONOLULU** – Today marks two weeks since the state’s mandatory 14-day self-quarantine started for all passengers arriving in Hawaii from out of state. Those who arrived on March 26<sup>th</sup> no longer need to self-quarantine. Yesterday, 689 people arrived in Hawaii including 107 visitors and 274 residents. In comparison, during this same time last year, nearly 30,000 passengers arrived in Hawaii daily, including residents and visitors. The quarantine order was expanded on April 1<sup>st</sup> to include interisland travelers. This table shows the number of people who arrived by air from out of state yesterday and does not include interisland travel.
