Hawai'i Passenger Arrivals By Air

HONOLULU – Today marks two weeks since the state's mandatory 14-day self-quarantine started for all passengers arriving in Hawai'i from out of state. Those who arrived on March 26th no longer need to self-quarantine. Yesterday, 689 people arrived in Hawai'i including 107 visitors and 274 residents. In comparison, during this same time last year, nearly 30,000 passengers arrived in Hawai'i daily, including residents and visitors. The quarantine order was expanded on April 1st to include interisland travelers. This table shows the number of people who arrived by air from out of state yesterday and does not include interisland travel.
