## Hawai'i Passenger Arrivals By Air

**HONOLULU** – Yesterday, 663 people arrived in Hawai'i including 107 visitors and 171 residents. In comparison, during this same time last year, nearly 30,000 passengers arrived in Hawai'i daily, including residents and visitors. Yesterday marked two weeks since the state's mandatory 14-day self-quarantine started for all passengers arriving in Hawai'i from out of state. Those who arrived on March 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> no longer need to self-quarantine. The quarantine order was expanded on April 1<sup>st</sup> to include interisland travelers. This table shows the number of people who arrived by air from out of state yesterday and does not include interisland travel.
