

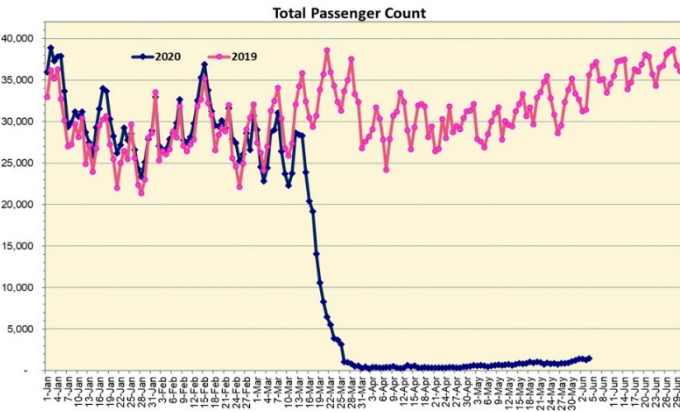

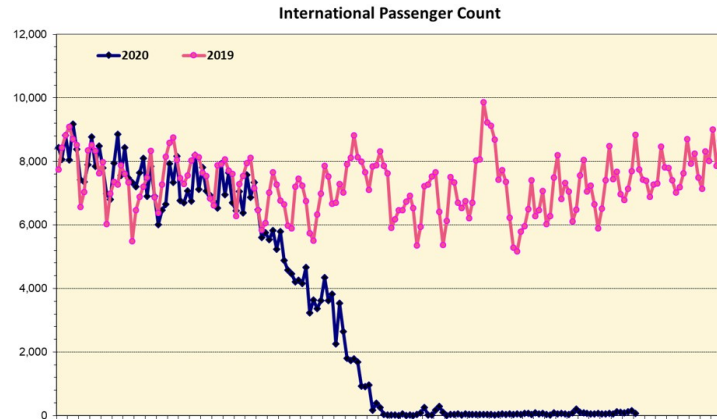

COVID-19 Positive* Cases

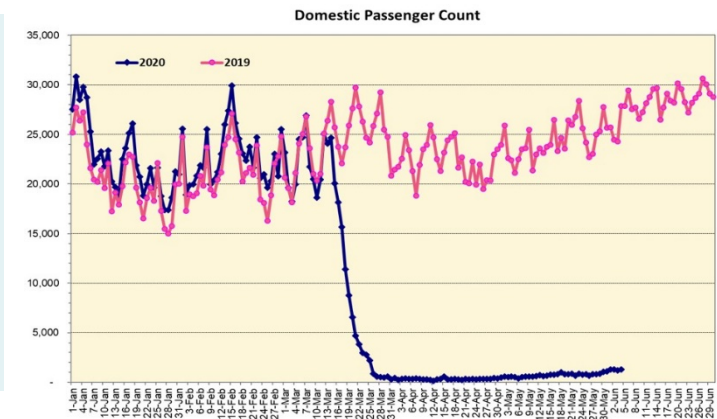
Cumulative totals as of 12:00 noon on June 5, 2020

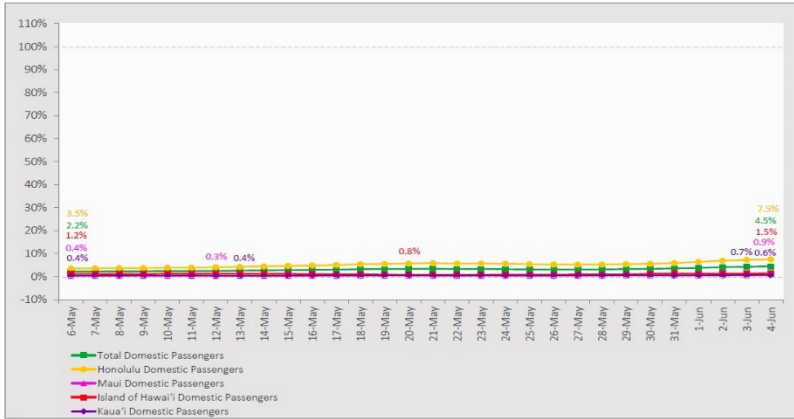

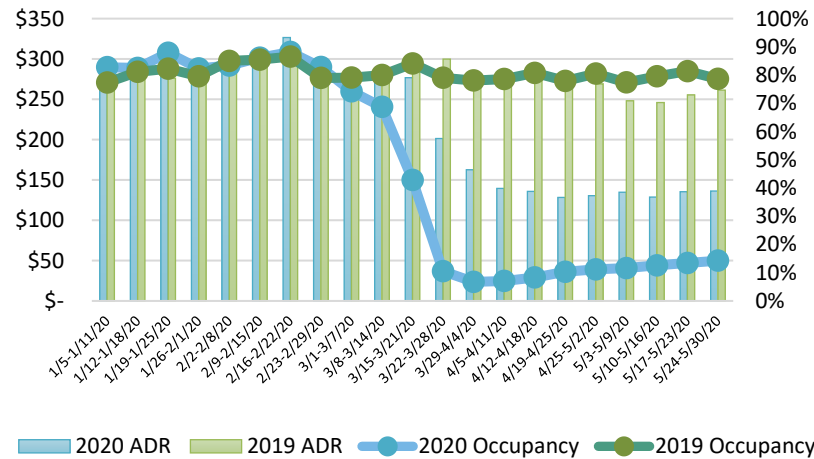

State of Hawai'i Hotel Performance by Week - 2020 vs 2019



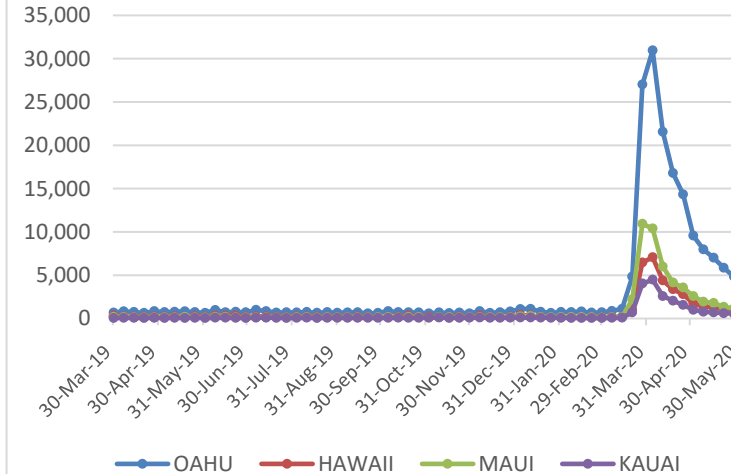

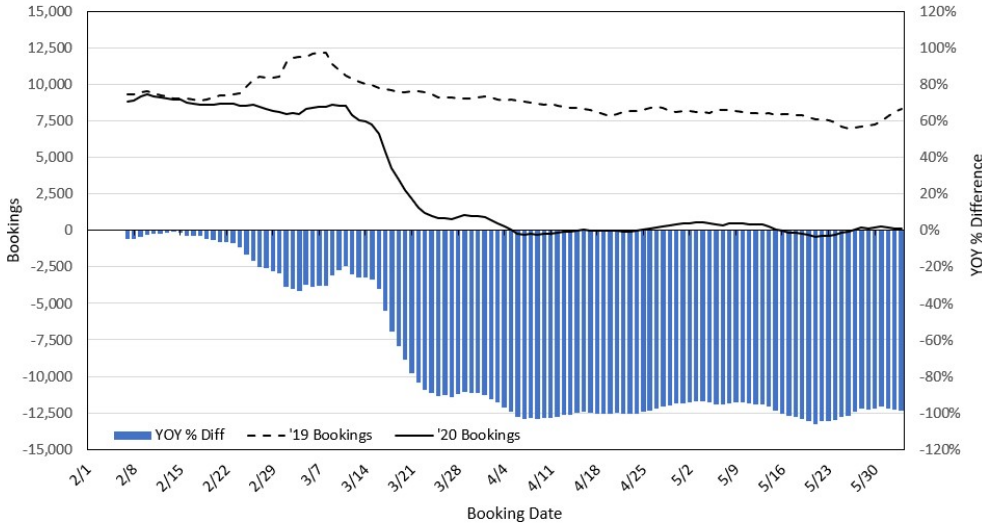

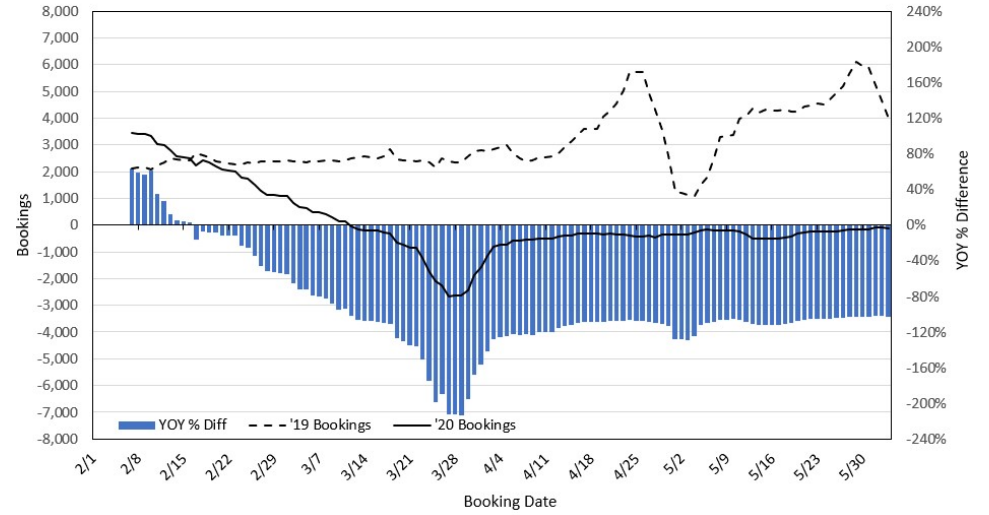

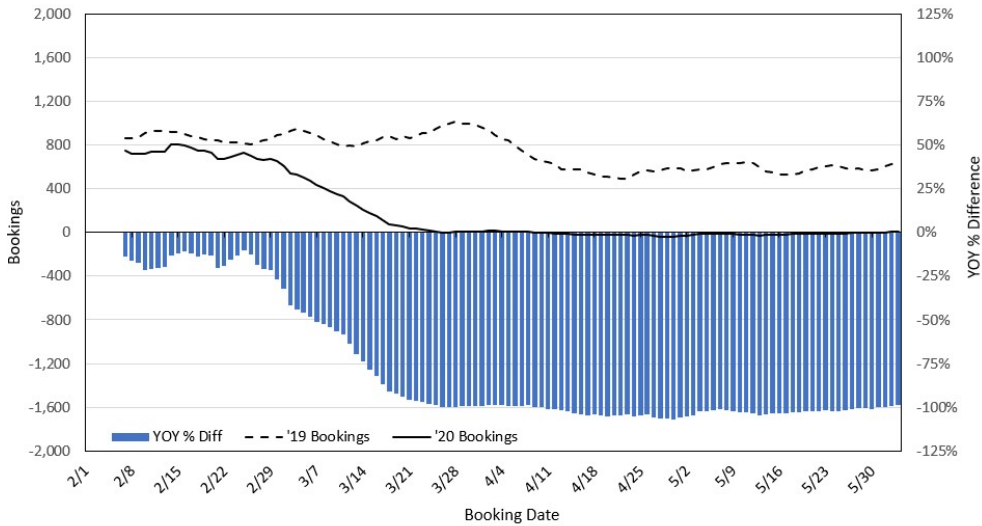

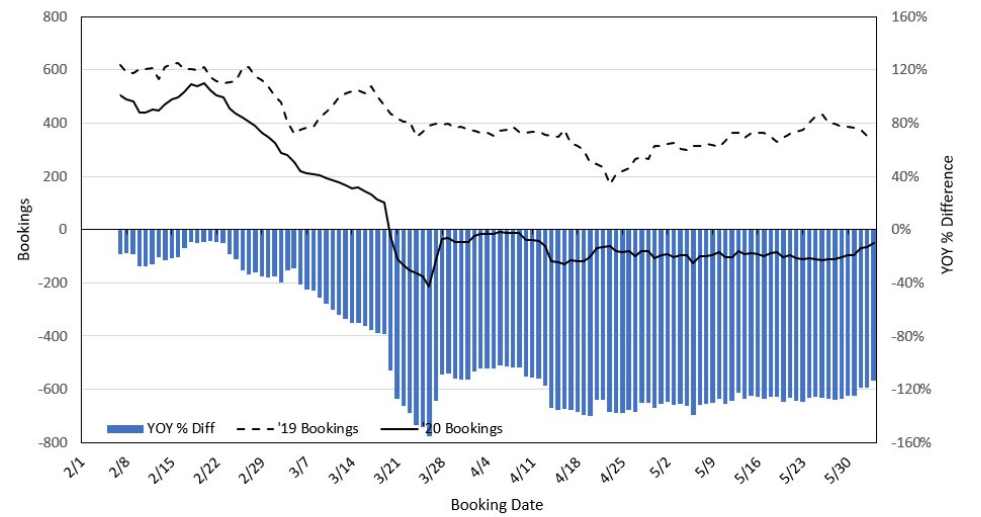

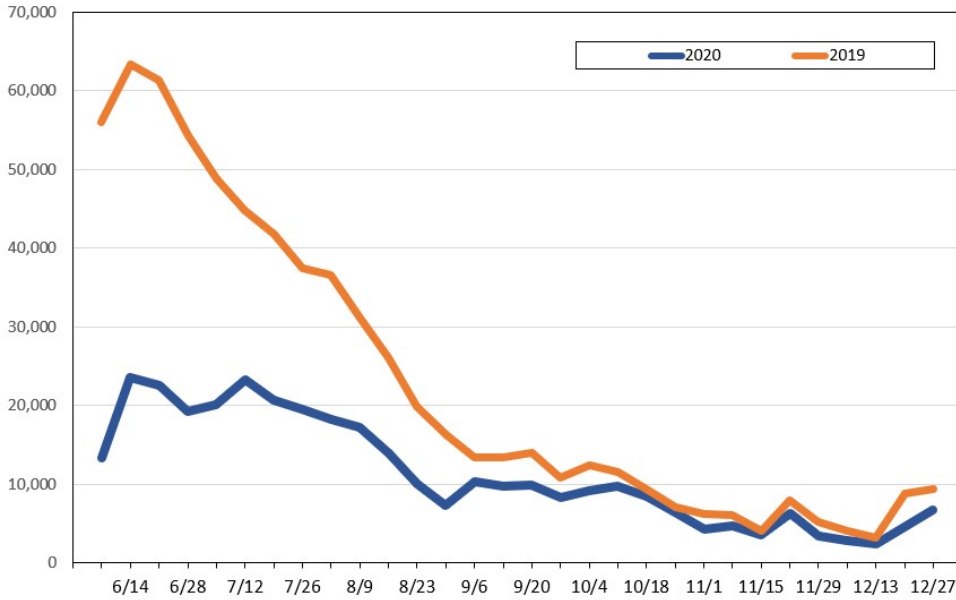

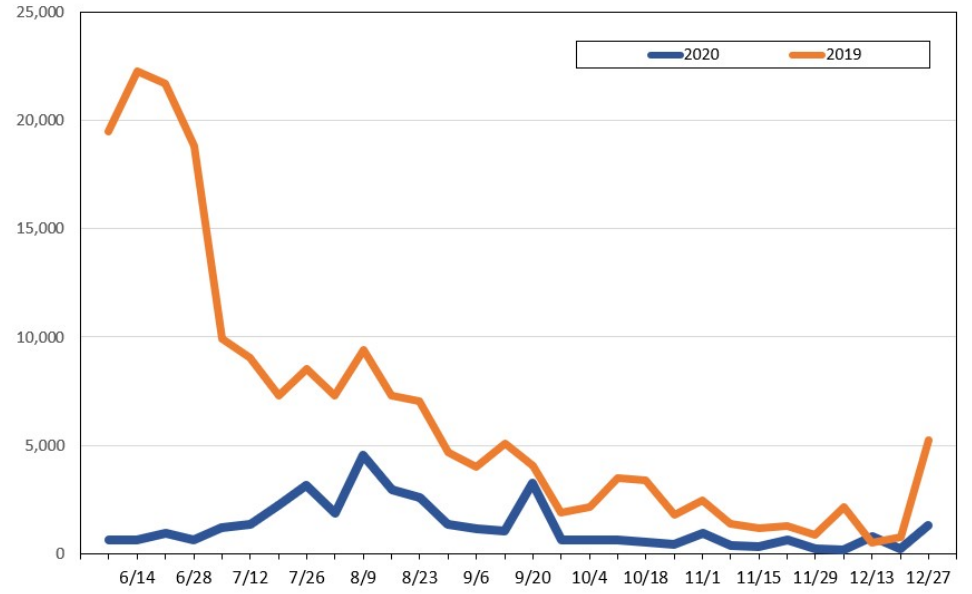

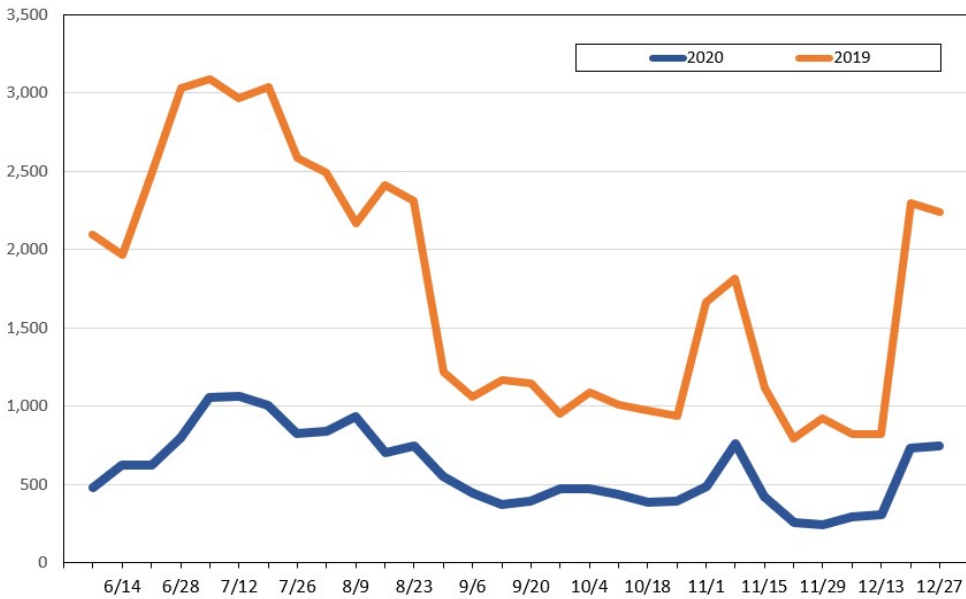

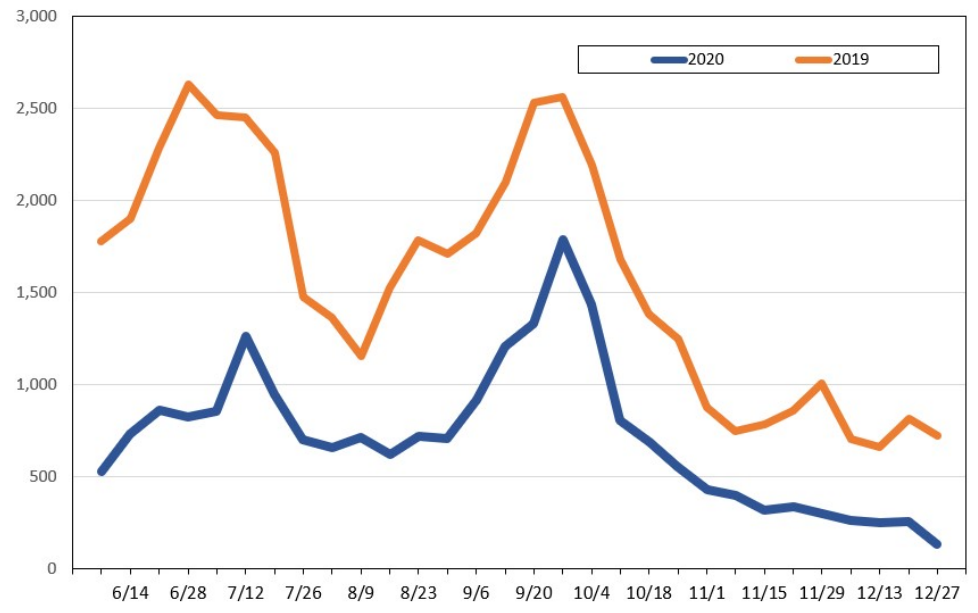
