## Hawai'i Passenger Arrivals By Air

**HONOLULU** – Yesterday, 1,656 people arrived in Hawaiʻi. During this same time last year, nearly 30,000 passengers arrived in Hawaiʻi daily, including residents and visitors. The state's mandatory 14-day self-quarantine started on March 26<sup>th</sup> for all passengers arriving in Hawaiʻi from out of state. The quarantine order was expanded on April 1<sup>st</sup> to include interisland travelers. This table shows the number of people who arrived by air from out of state yesterday and does not include interisland travel. This data was collected from the Hawaiʻi Department of Transportation's (DOT) Mandatory Travel Declaration Form.

**Crew** = flight crew members

**Transit** = people who are in transit to another location through Hawai'i and aren't leaving the airport **Military** = military exempt personnel

**Exempt** = people who are exempt from the 14-day quarantine after receiving prior approval from the state **Relocate to Hawai'i** = people who are moving to Hawai'i

**Returning Resident** = people who indicate on the DOT's form that they're returning residents

Visitor = people who are not in the above categories
