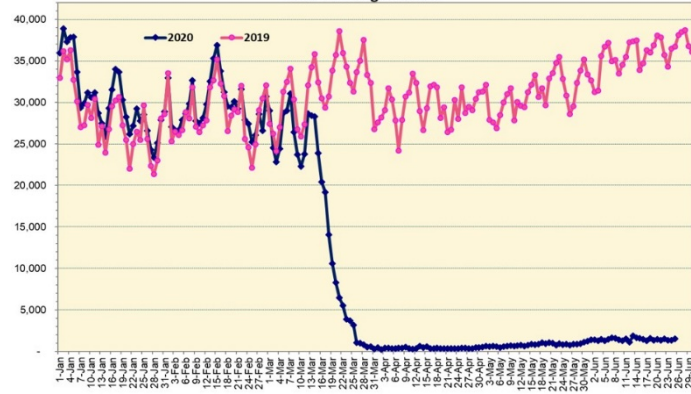

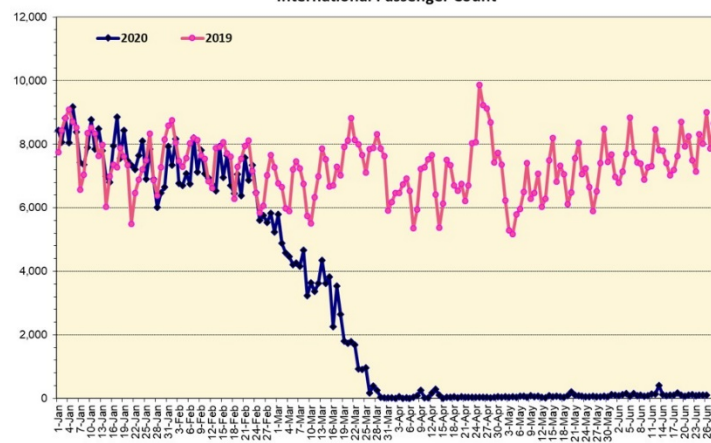

Total Passenger Count



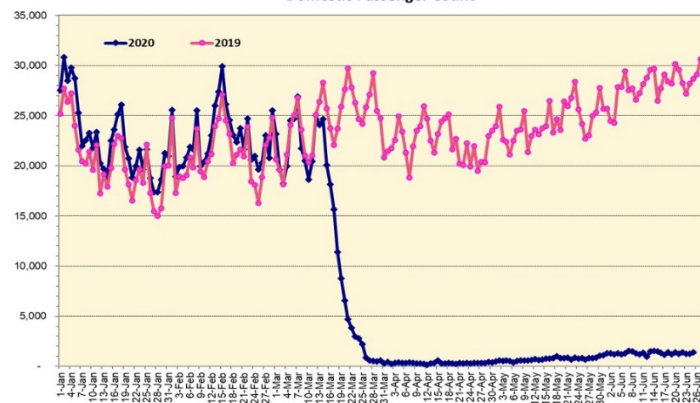

6/26/20 Hawaii Passenger Arrivals by Air Update

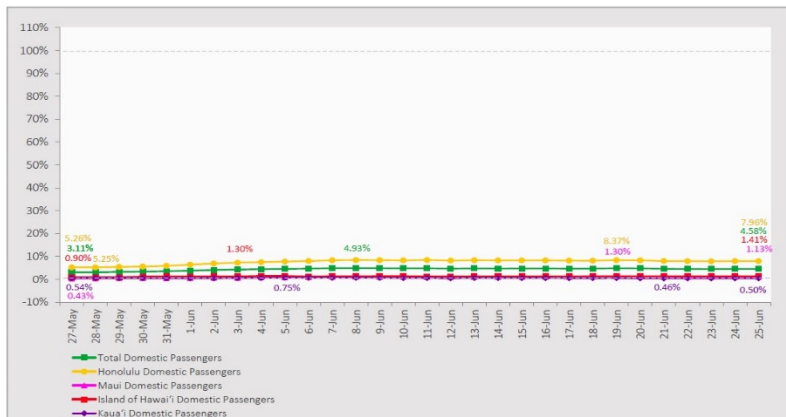

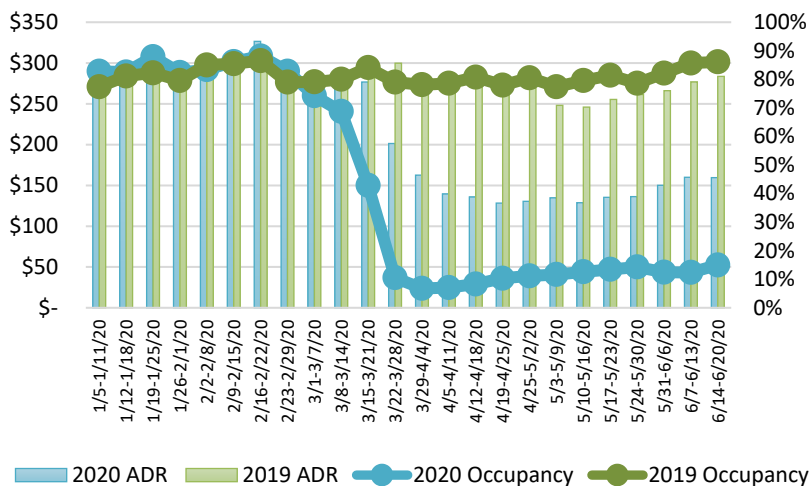

State of Hawai'i Hotel Performance by Week - 2020 vs 2019



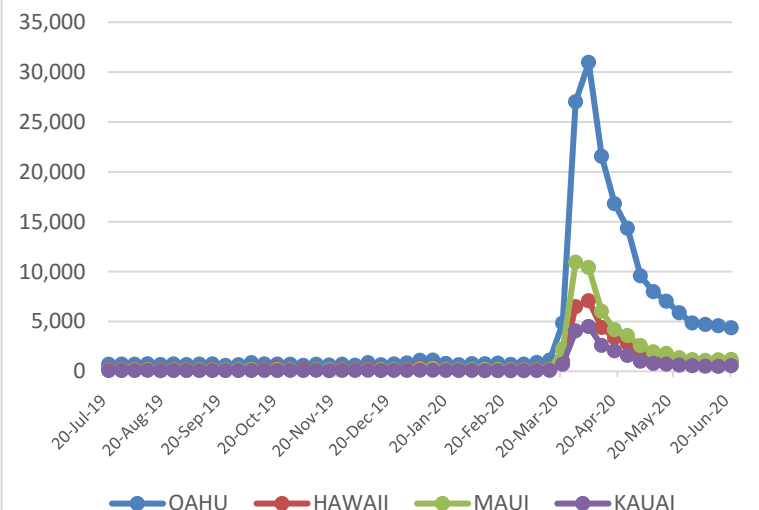

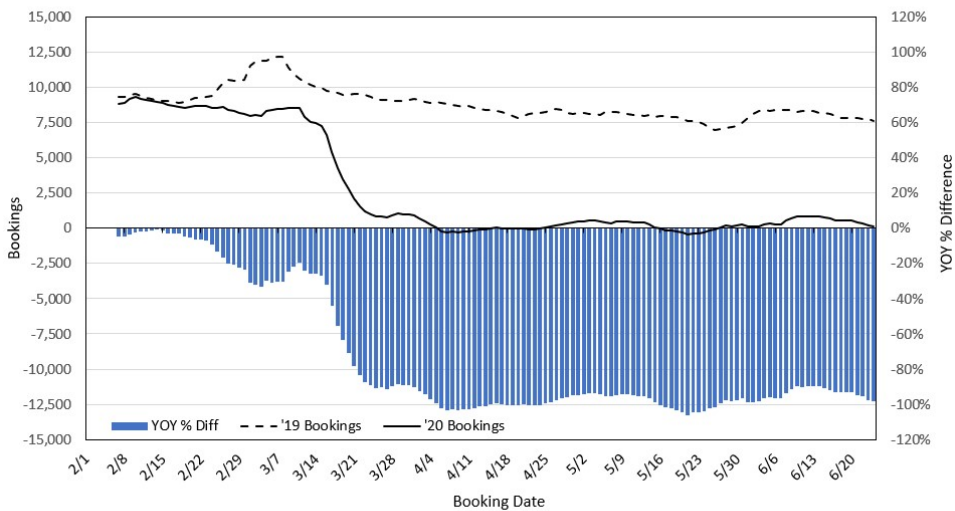
2020 Initial Weekly Unemployment Claims by Island

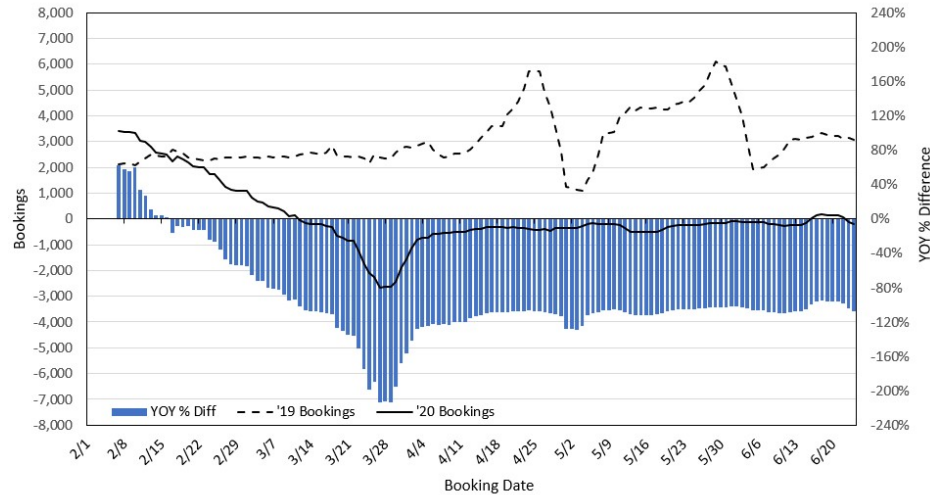
Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

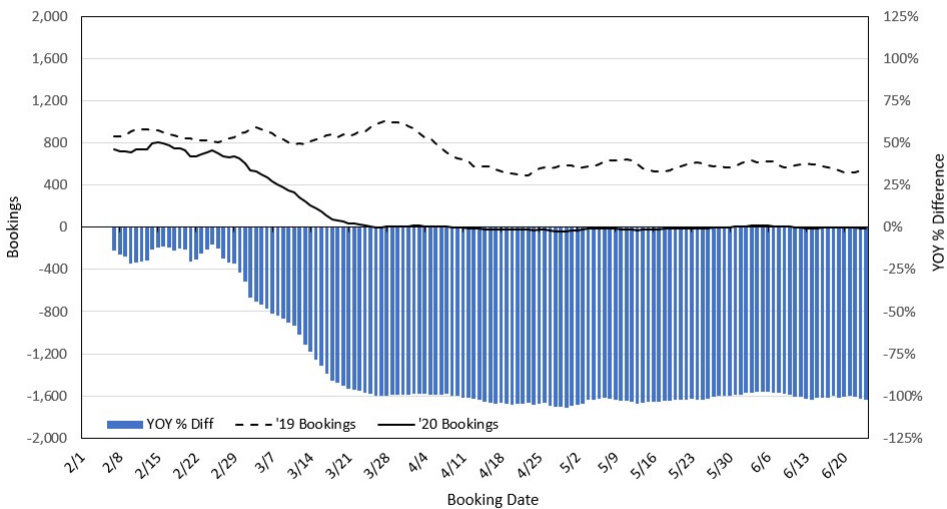
Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

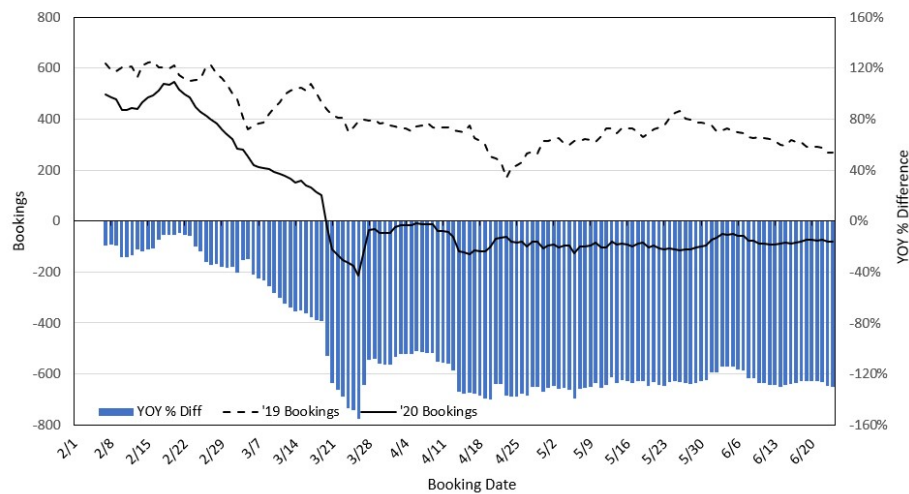
Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

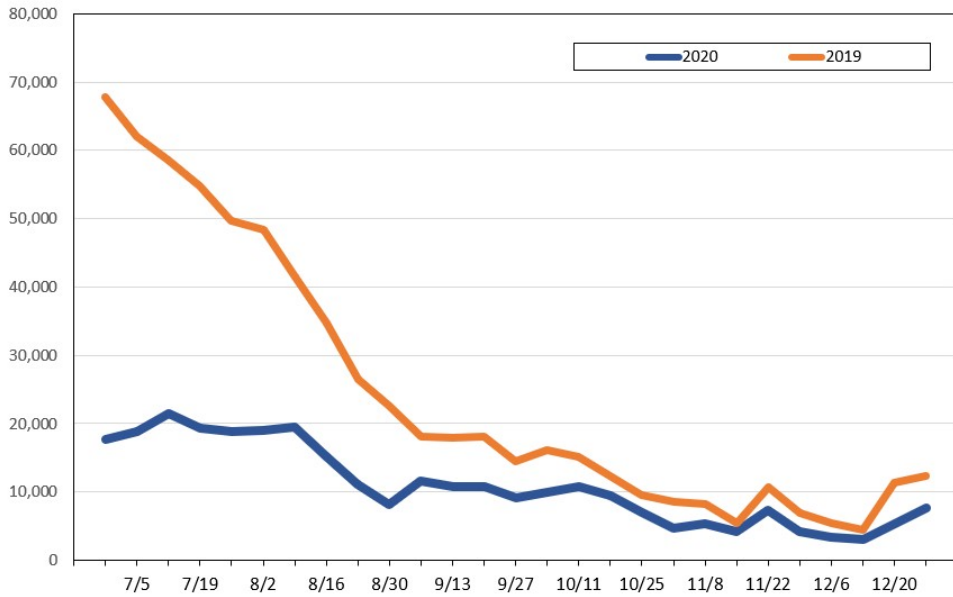

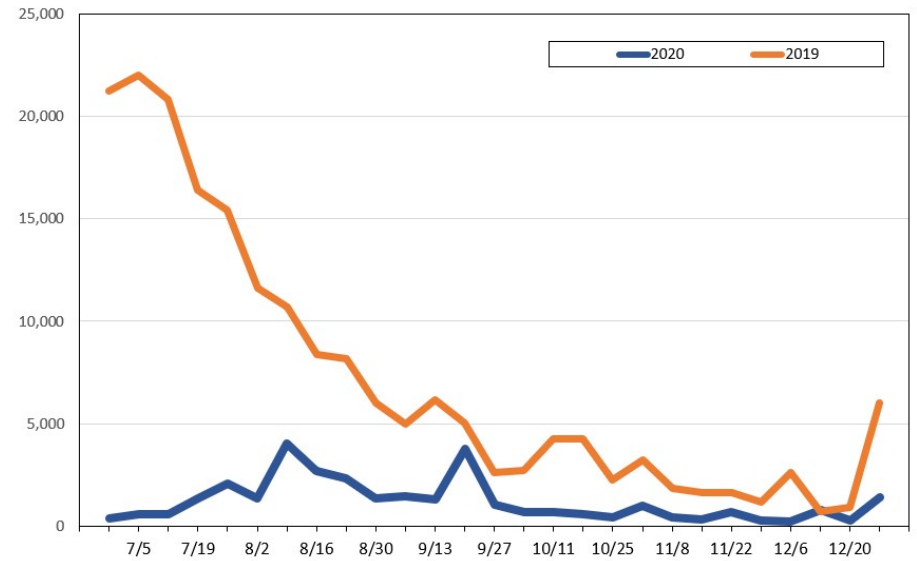

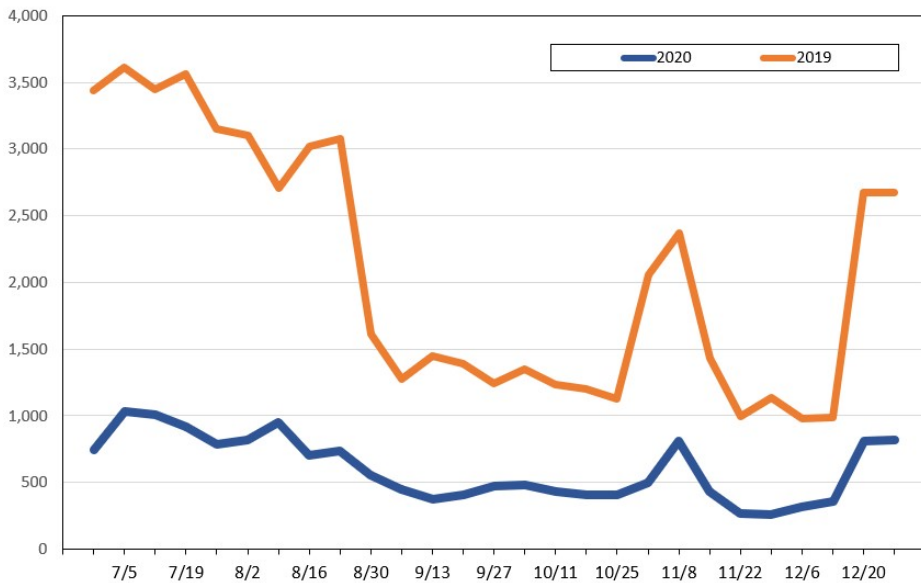

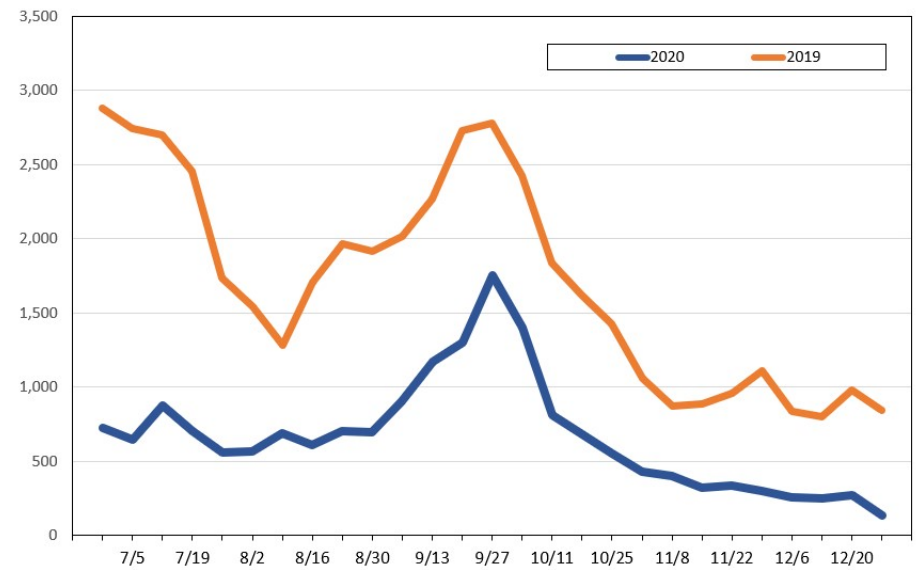
