

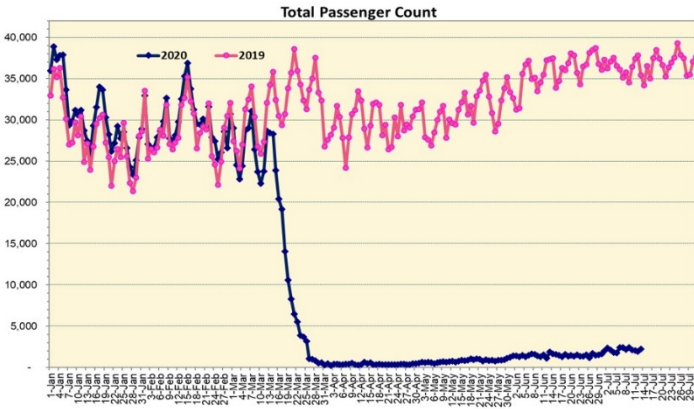

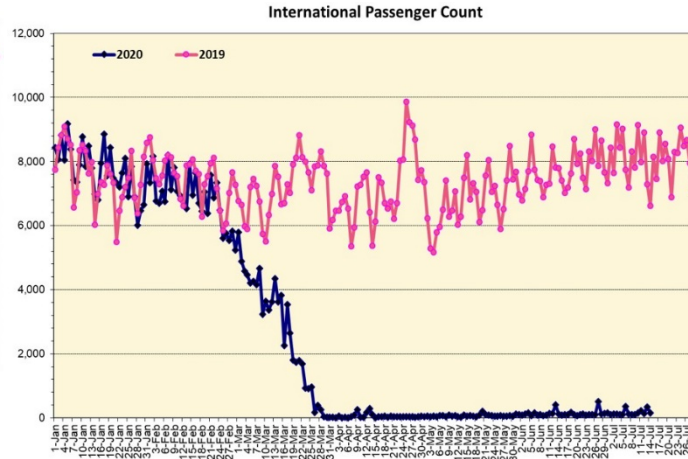

COVID-19 Positive* Cases

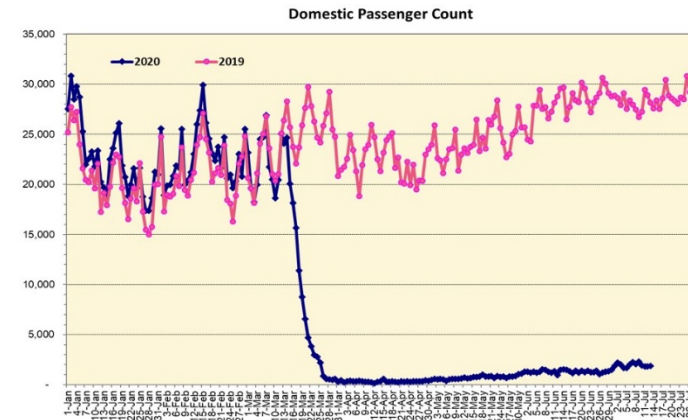
Cumulative totals as of 12:00 noon on July 14, 2020

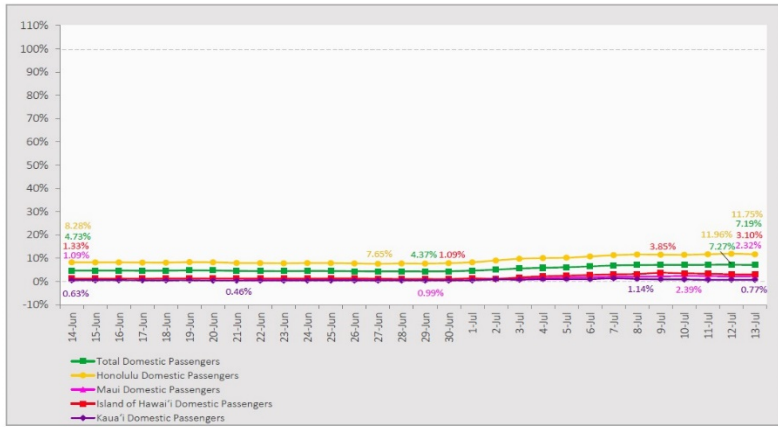

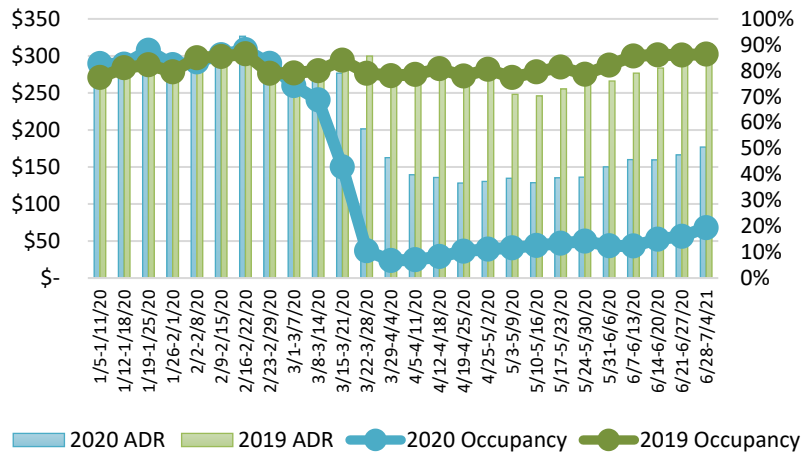

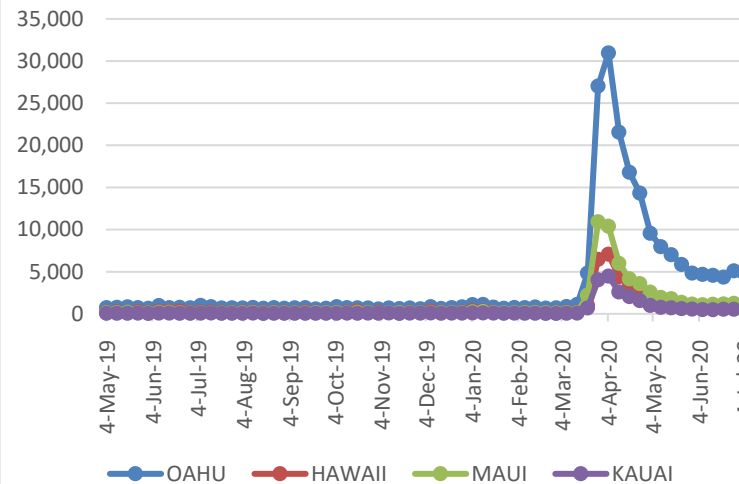

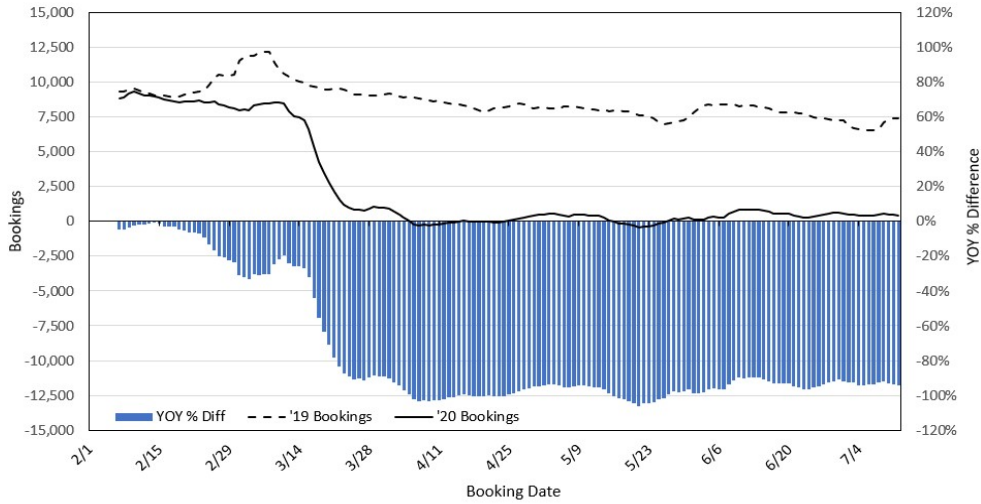

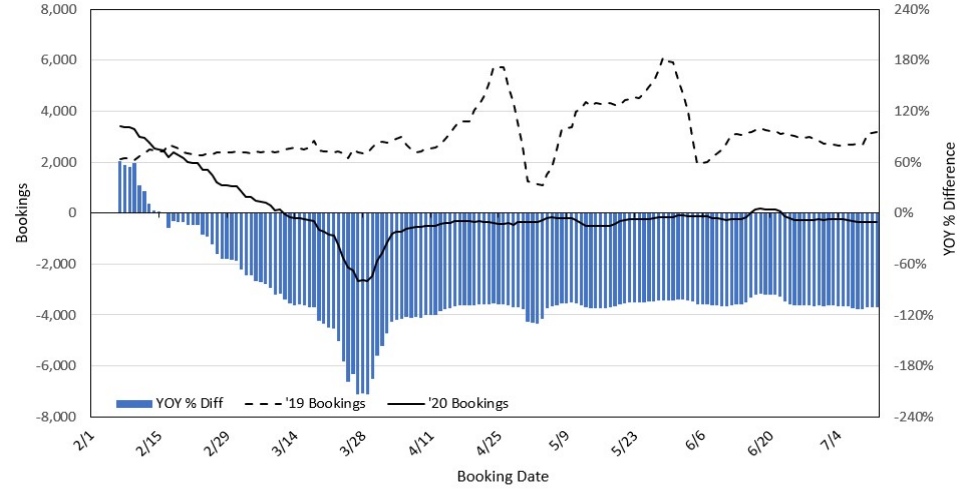
**Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

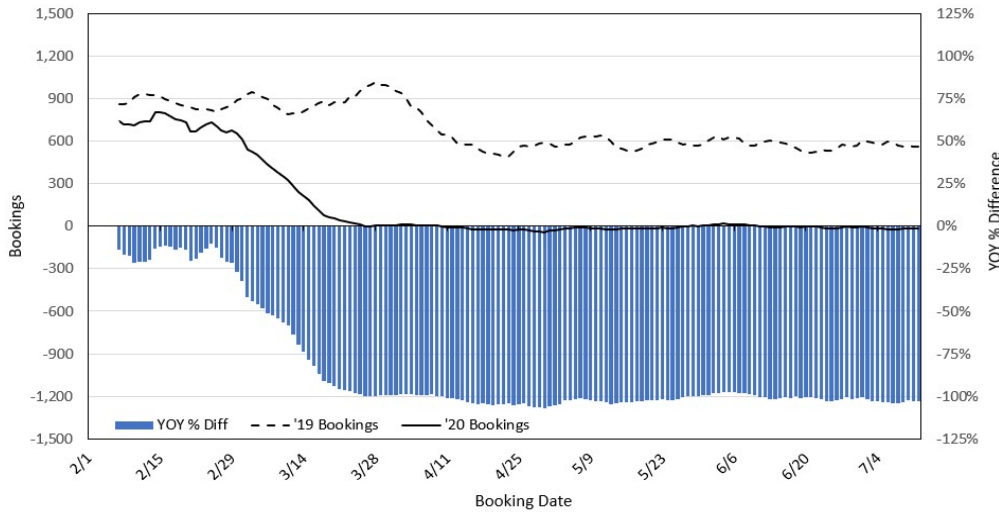
**Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

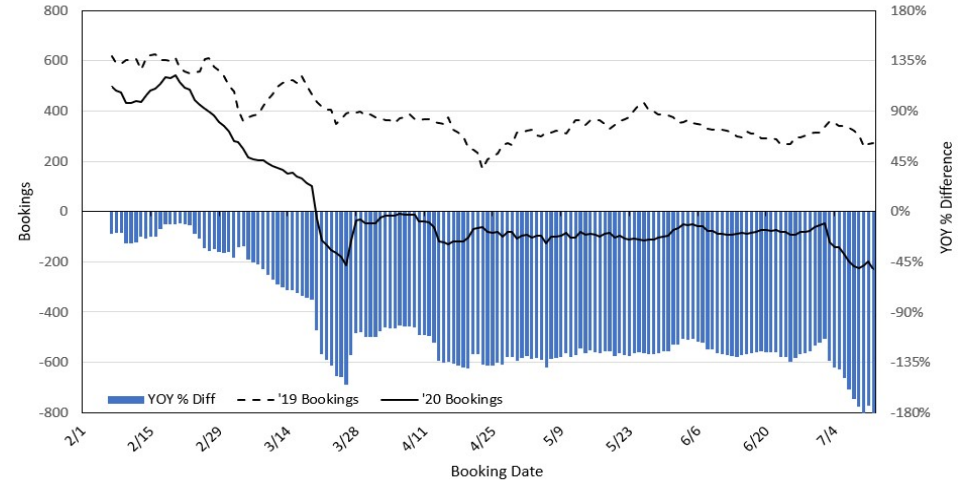
**Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

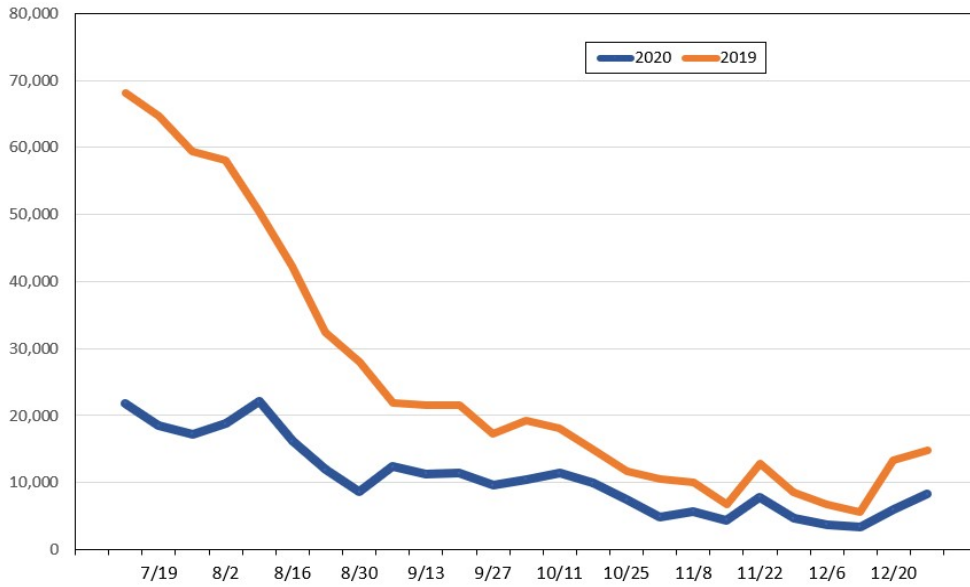
**Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

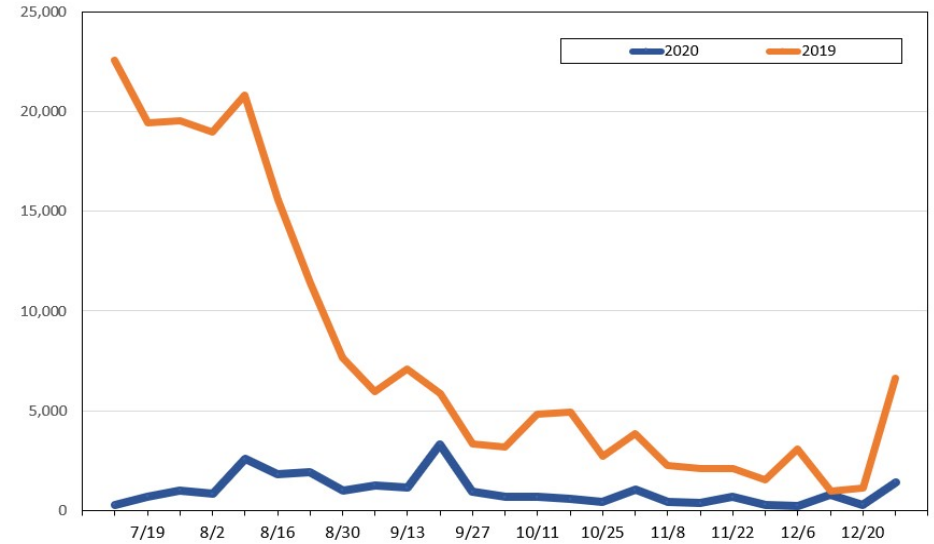

U.S.**



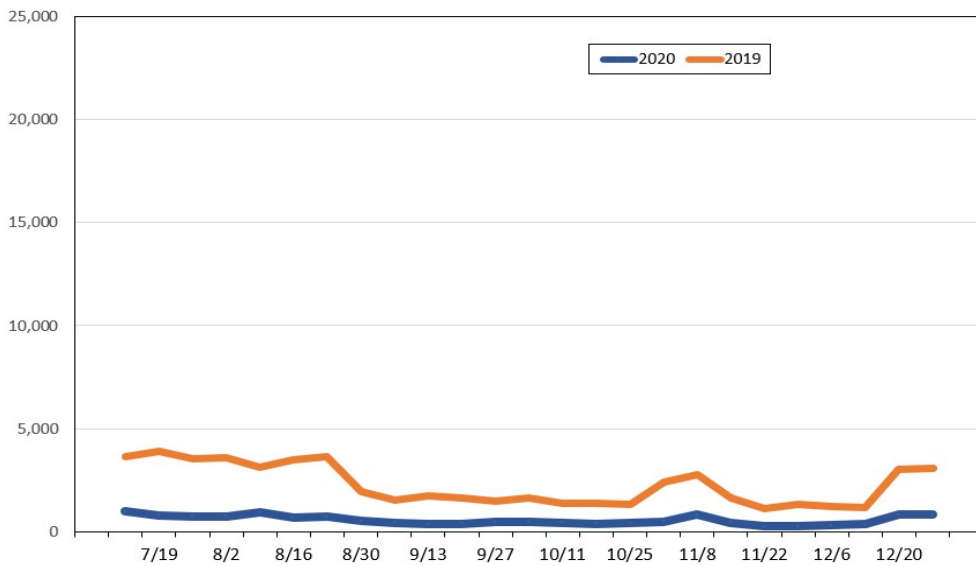

Japan**



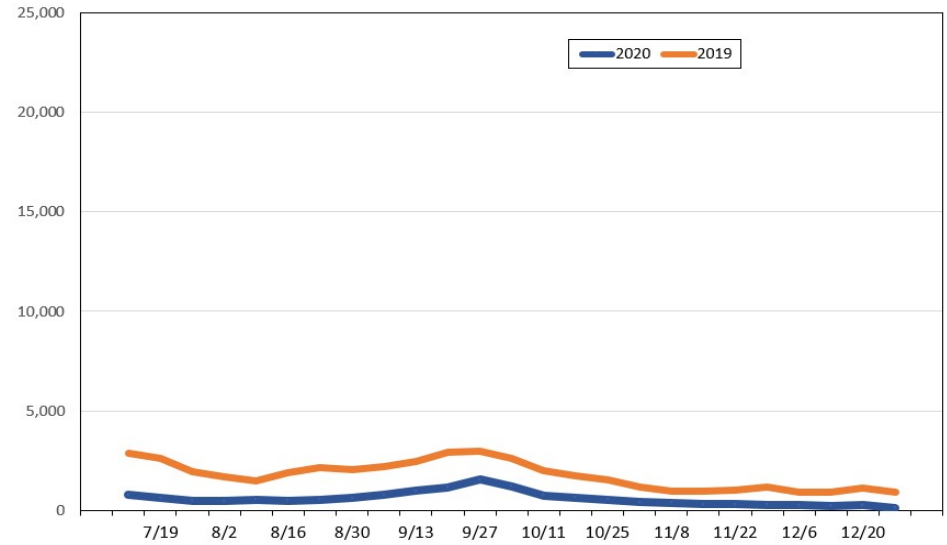
