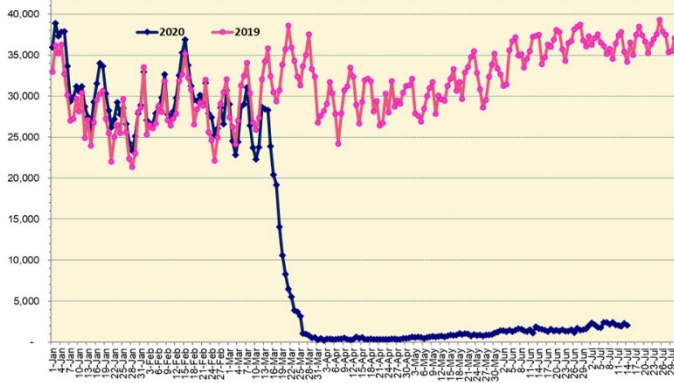

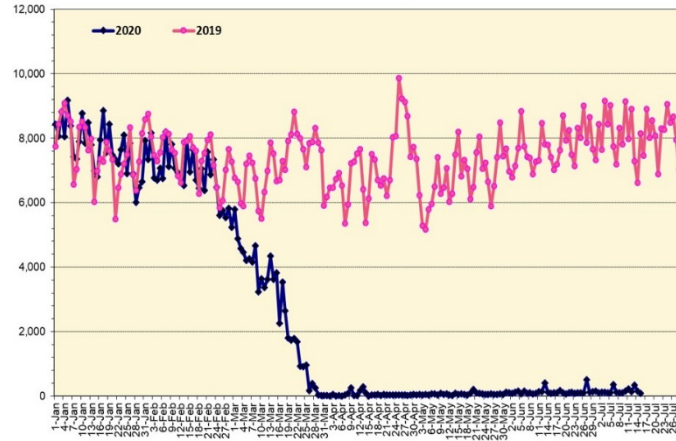

Total Passenger Count



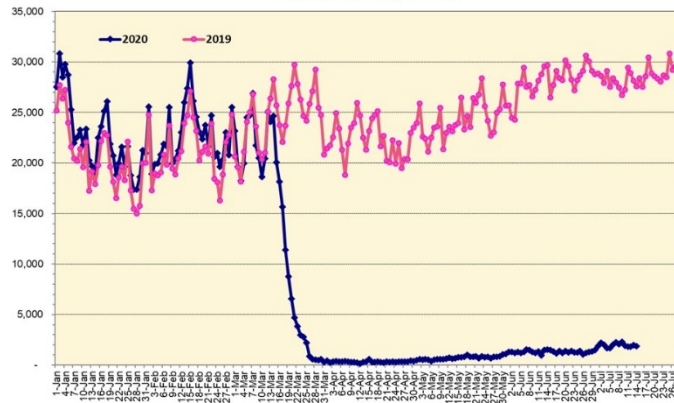

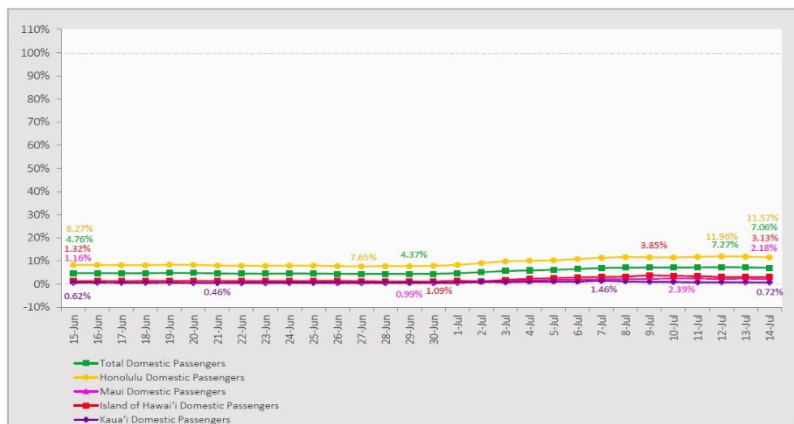

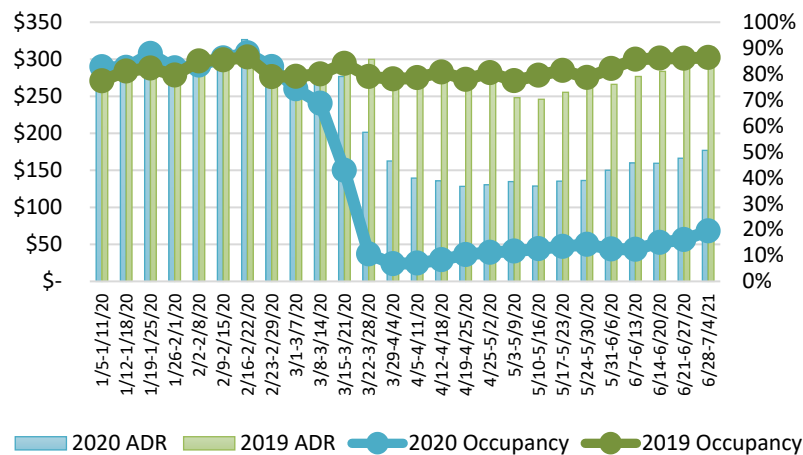

State of Hawai'i Hotel Performance by Week - 2020 vs 2019



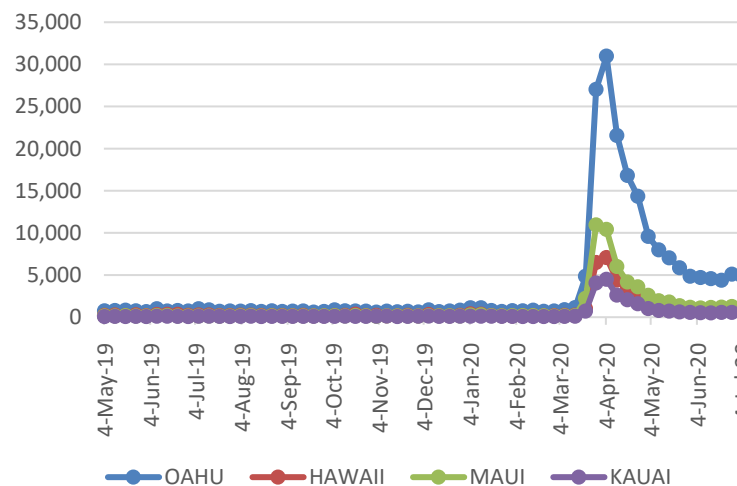

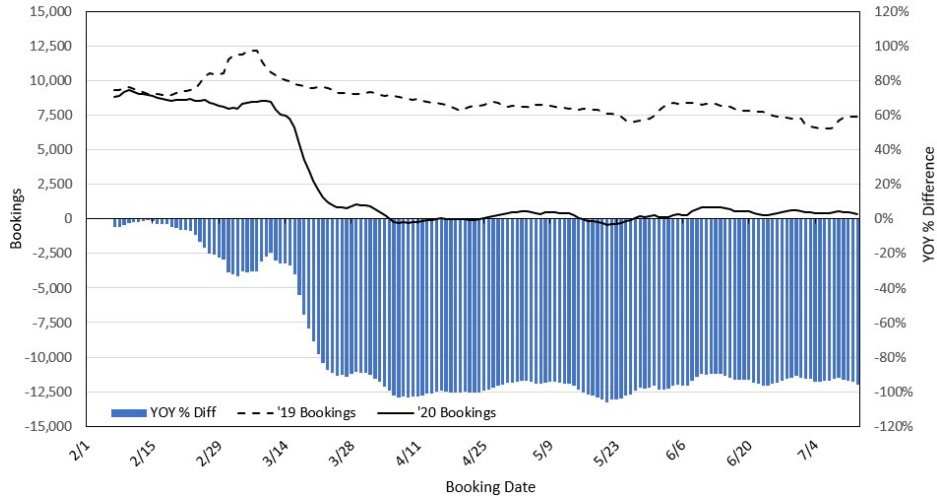
2020 Initial Weekly Unemployment Claims by Island

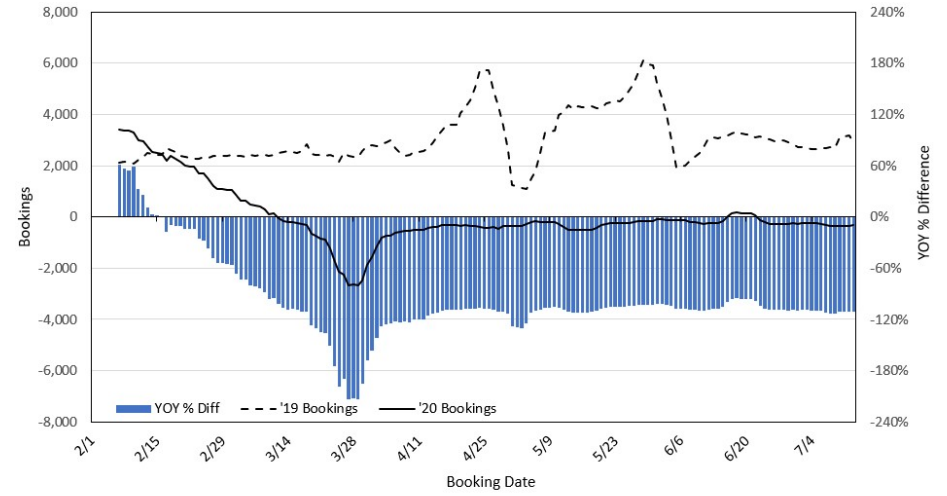
Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

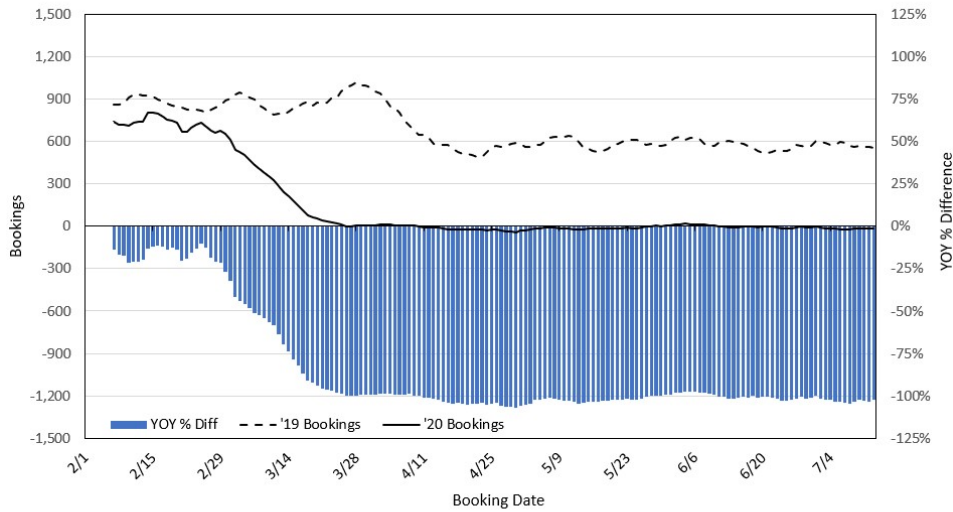
Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals*

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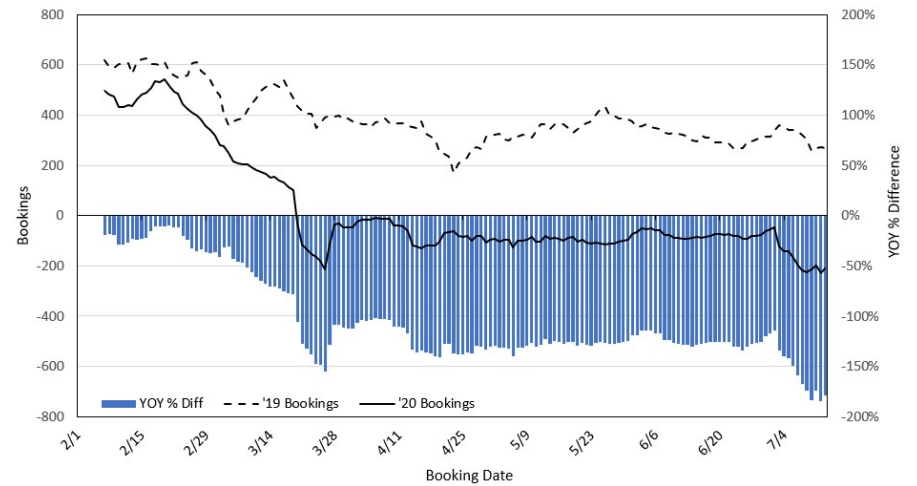

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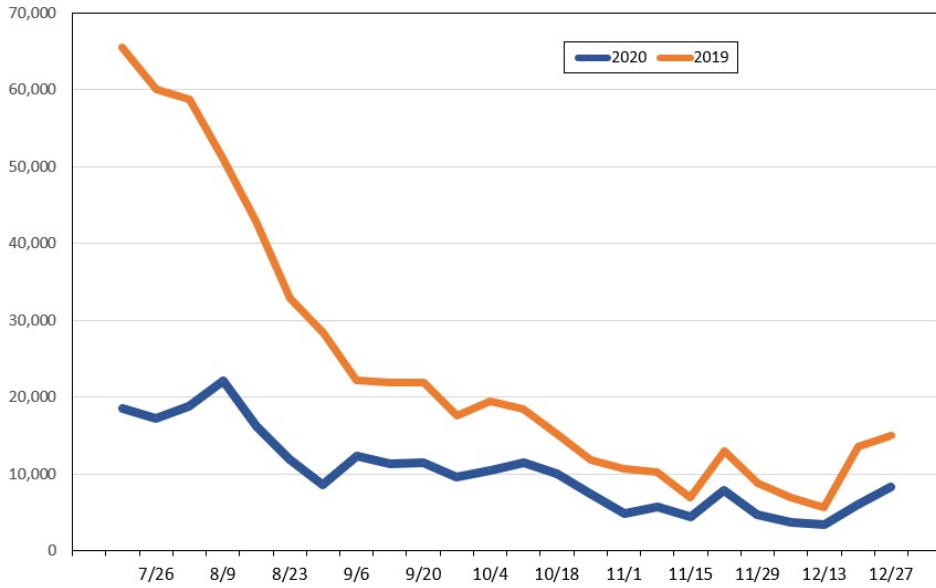

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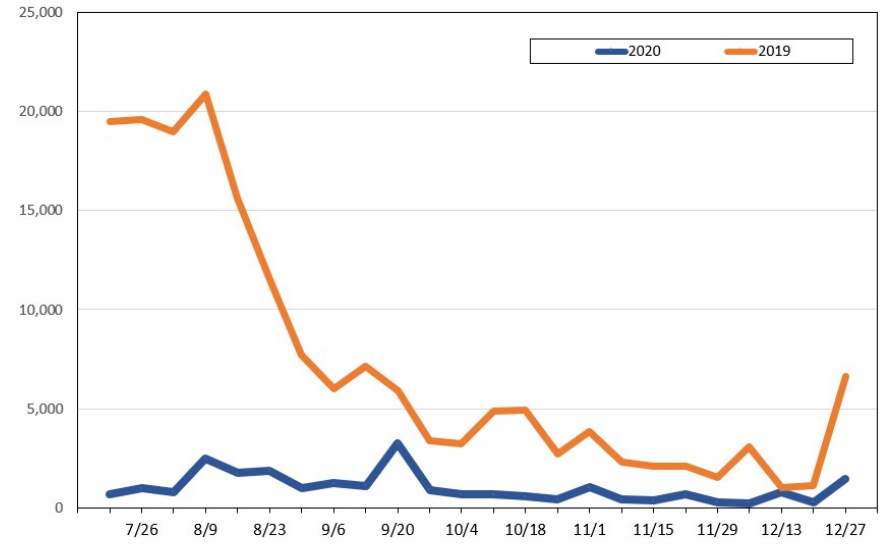
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Travel Agency Bookings for Future Travel to Hawai'i as of July 13, 2020

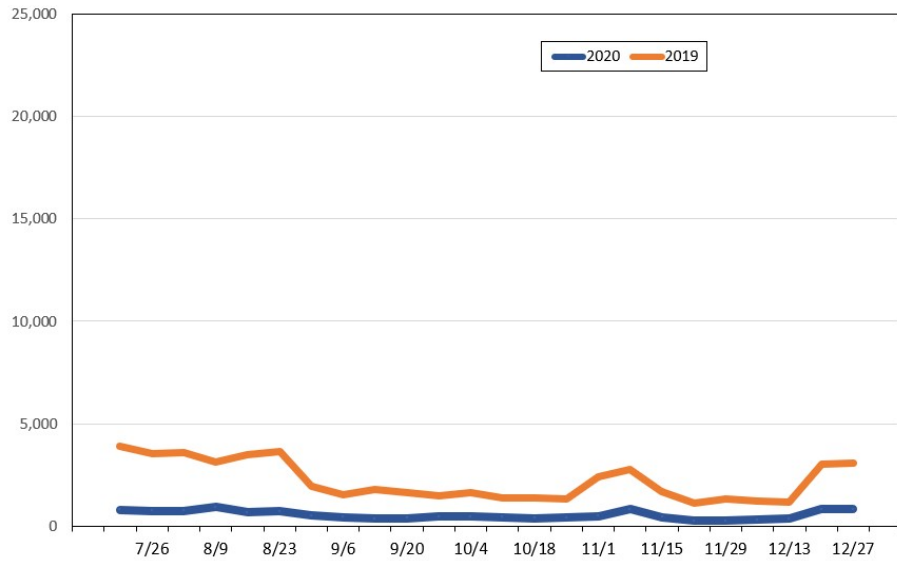

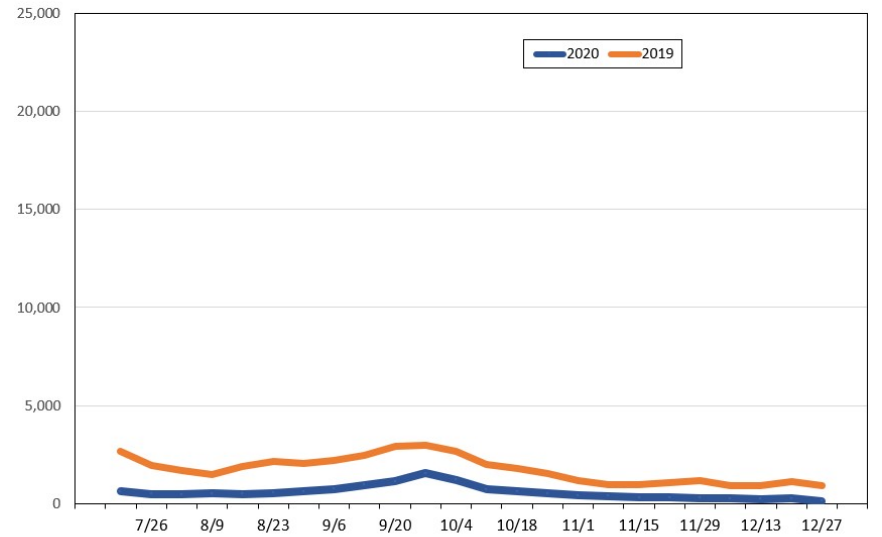
