




7/23/20 Hawaii Passenger Arrivals by Air Update







7-Day Domestic by Island Moving Average Daily Passenger Volume





Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals* Based on a 7-day Moving Average, 2020 vs 2019 U.S.











Travel Agency Weekly Bookings for Future Travel to Hawai'i as of July 21, 2020 U.S.




Travel Agency Weekly Bookings for Future Travel to Hawai'i as of July 21, 2020 Canada


