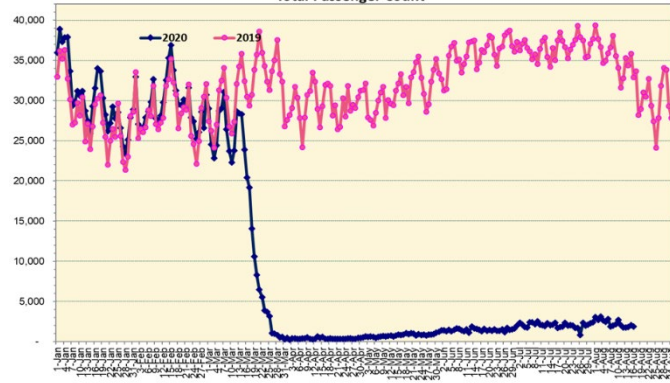

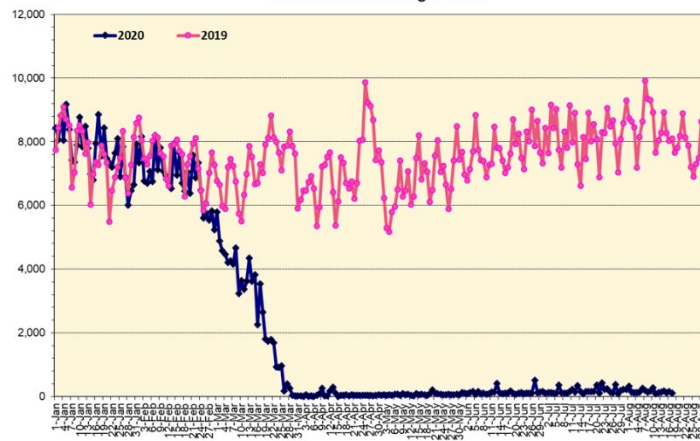

Total Passenger Count



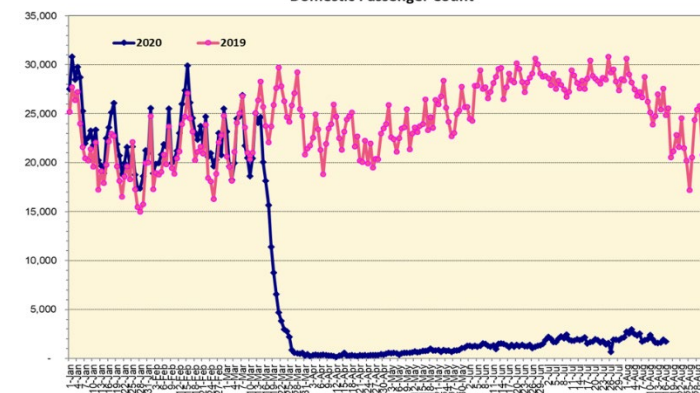

### 8/17/20 Hawaii Passenger Arrivals by Air Update

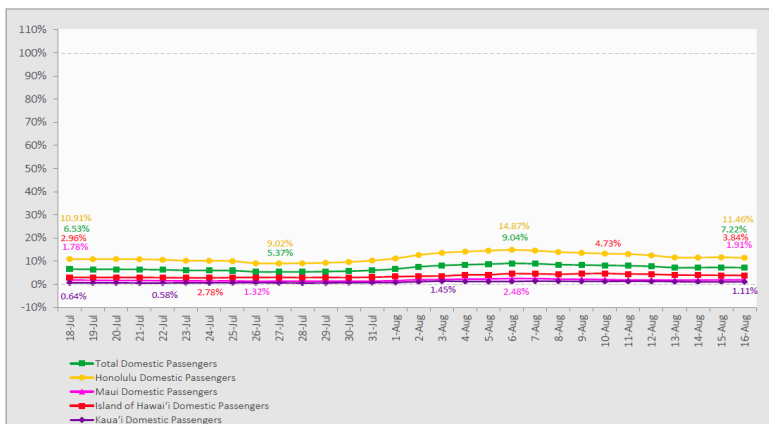

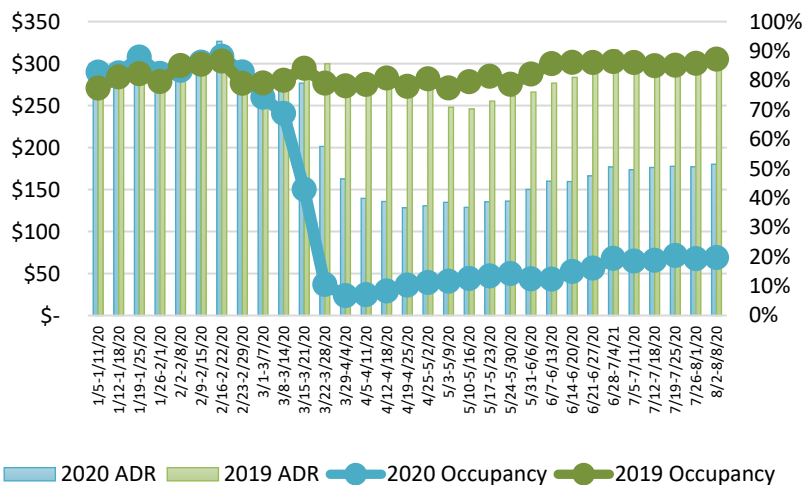

### State of Hawai'i Hotel Performance by Week - 2020 vs 2019



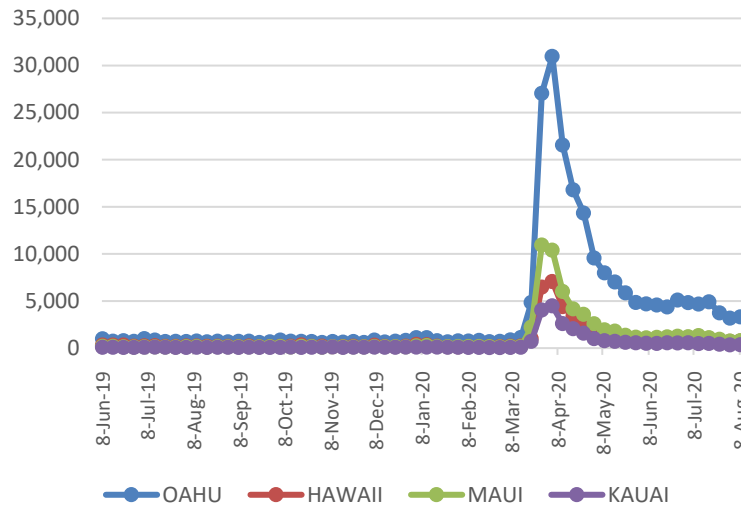

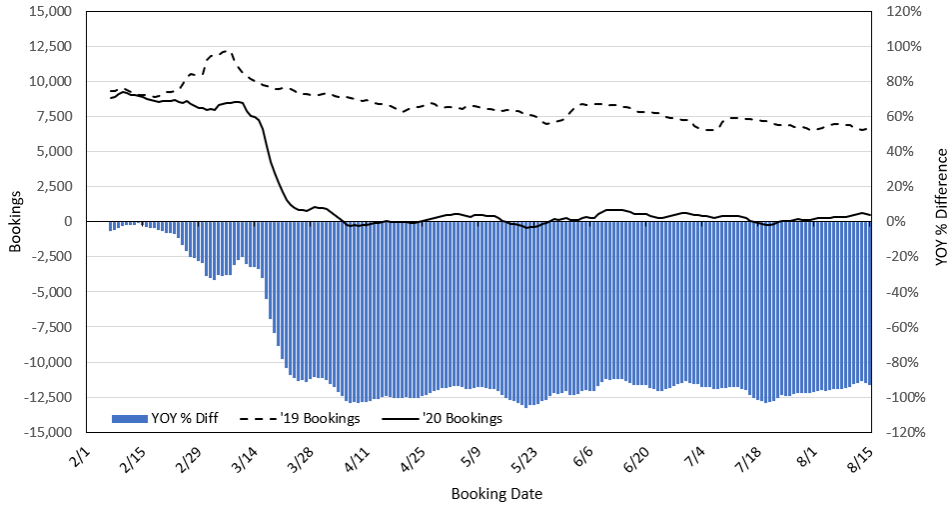

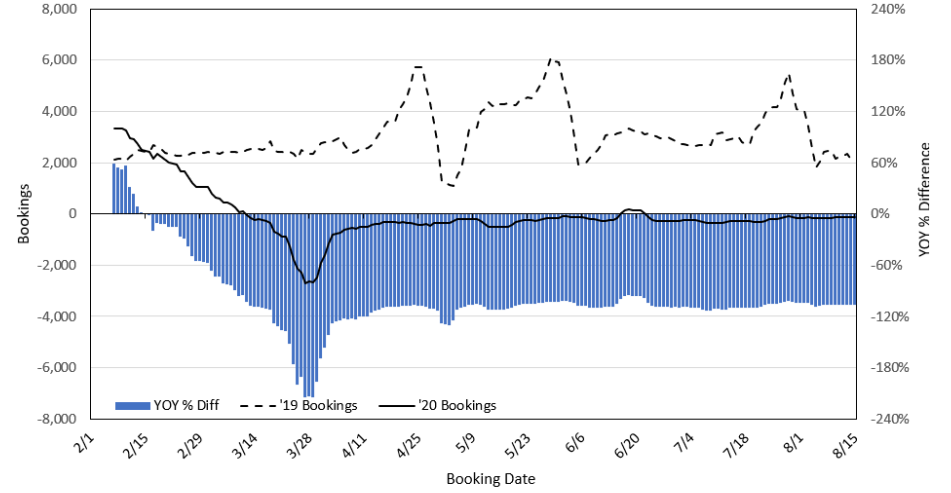
**Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals\***

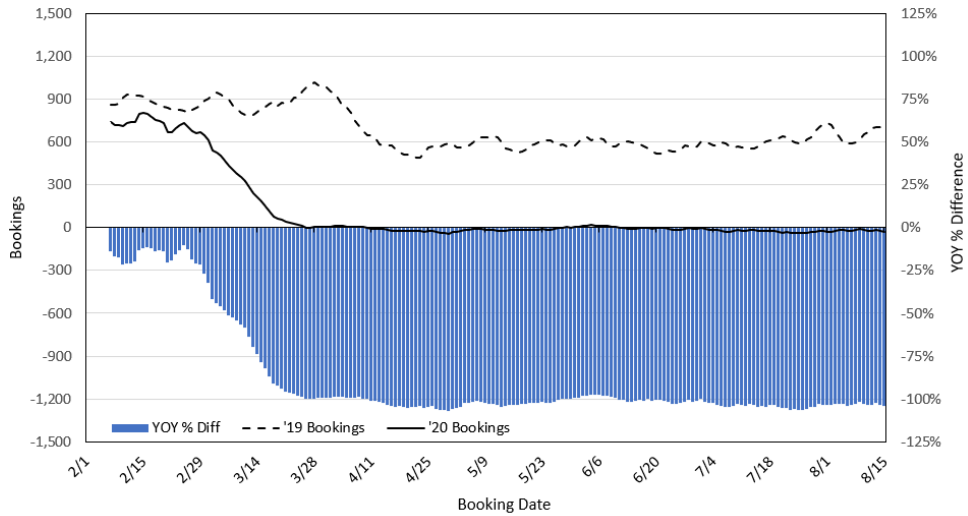
**Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals\***

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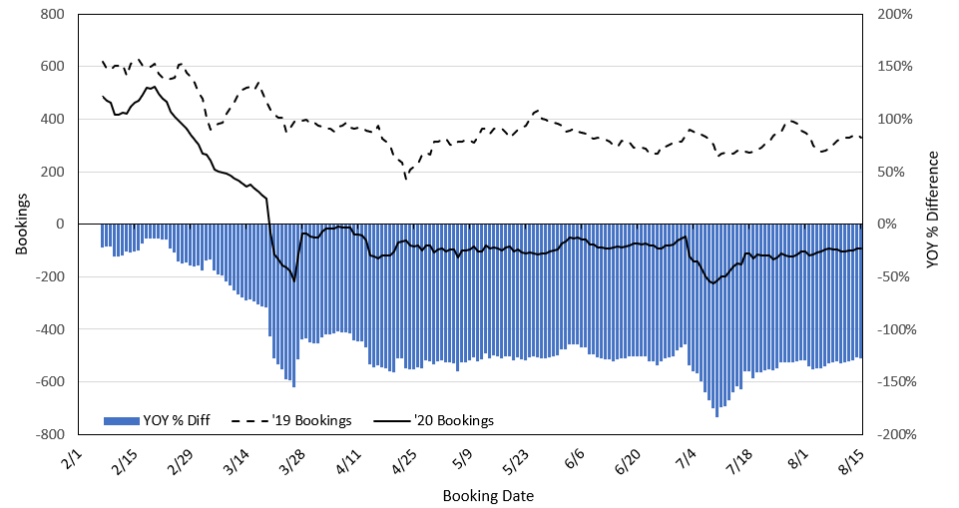

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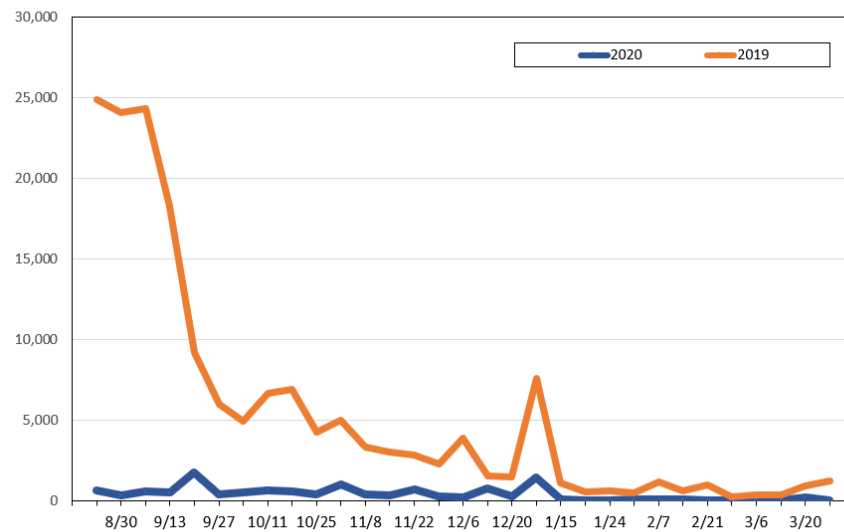

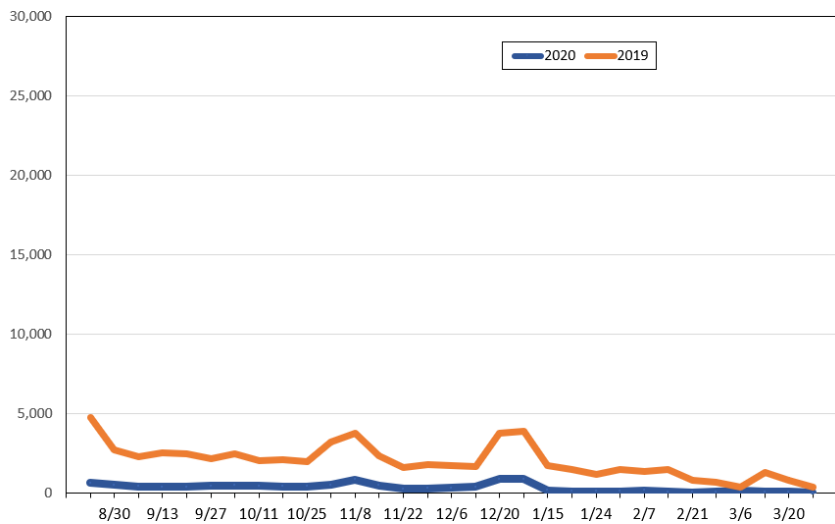

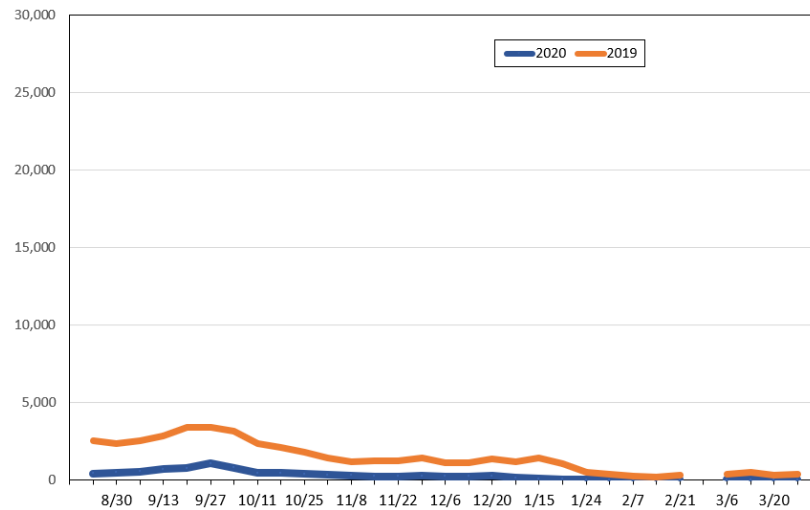
