



This proxy number for "active cases" resolves classification issues for cases unable to be reached or who are out of jurisdiction, for whom precise release from isolation date may not be possible to determine. It is also not influenced by lags in data entry. (This total does not include Hawaii residents diagnosed outside of Hawaii)


[†]One case is a Lanai resident whose exposure is on Maui Island and who will be remaining on Maui Island for the interim.

Positive cases include confirmed cases, and Hawaii residents and nonresidents; data are preliminary and subject to change. Note that CDC provides case counts according to states of residence.








Travel Agency Bookings to Hawaii for Future Arrivals* Based on a 7-day Moving Average as of April 6, 2021












